Summary

This collection consists of records related to news articles mentioning Elizabeth Warren and bankruptcy law, Bankruptcy, Reorganization, and Creditors' Rights Abstracts (BRCRA) electronic newsletters, the proposed 1999 Bankruptcy Reform, Reduction and Simplification Act, and Bankruptcy Reform Act of 2000. This collection contains emails and electronic records.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0723-F (Segment 1) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Elizabeth Warren is a United States Senator from Massachusetts since 2013. During the 1990s, she specialized in bankruptcy law as a professor at the University of Pennsylvania Law School and Harvard Law School. She later served as an advisor for the National Bankruptcy Review Commission and Special Advisor to the Secretary of the Treasury on the creation of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB). Materials responsive to this FOIA request include emails of news articles mentioning Elizabeth Warren and bankruptcy law, Bankruptcy, Reorganization, and Creditors' Rights Abstracts (BRCRA) electronic newsletters, the proposed 1999 Bankruptcy Reform, Reduction and Simplification Act, and Bankruptcy Reform Act of 2000.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]; Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Tape Restoration Project [Email]; Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) White House Database (WHODB); and Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The Tape Restoration Project (TRP) is a database consisting of restored emails from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) from July 1994 through June of 2000. The TRP is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The White House Database (WHODB) is a database of White House events and individuals that attended those events. The database also includes a log of individuals that received White House greeting correspondence. Data was entered and maintained by the Office of Correspondence, Social Office, and Office of Public Liaison. The electronic Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES) is a log of visitors/appointments to the White House and is arranged by name of visitor there-under by date.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain.
