**Summary**

This collection contains records regarding Ambassador J. Stapleton Roy and the former Yugoslavia. From 1996 to 1999, Ambassador Roy was the United States Ambassador to Indonesia, a country that has not recognized the independence of Kosovo. The records include two May 12, 1998 emails containing United States Information Agency (USIA) reports of international press stories.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2019-0893-F Segment 1 are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This FOIA case contains records regarding Ambassador J. Stapleton Roy and the conflicts in the former Yugoslavia between 1994 and 2001. The collection contains two March 12, 1998 emails containing United States Information Agency (USIA) reports of international press stories. Other records responsive to this FOIA request were closed for national security reasons.

**Biographical Note**

Ambassador Roy was the United States Ambassador to Indonesia from 1996 to 1999. While bilateral relations between Indonesia and Serbia hit a low point during these crises, Indonesia has refrained from officially recognizing the independence of Kosovo.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: ARMS Emails and Clinton Presidential Records: NSC Cable, Email, and Records Management Systems. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) was a database that contained email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system held, and allowed access to, unclassified Presidential email. The ARMS database was comprised of seven sub-series of email records called "buckets." The buckets generally represented a specific White House office. The buckets were titled: NPR for National Performance Review, NSC for National Security Council, OPD for Office of Policy Development, POTUS for President of the United States, WHO for White House Office, CEA for Council of Economic Advisers, and Default for emails not associated with an office. In 2022, the National Archives and Records Administration transferred the majority of Clinton ARMS and TRP records to a records management and access system called ERA. This changed the processing of ARMS and TRP records. For technical reasons, however, NSC emails remained in their own bucket. NSC ARMS emails are arranged by topic, there-under by bucket, and there-under chronologically by creation date.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

## **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which

governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
