## **Summary**

This collection contains records regarding Jack Zetkusic and the former Yugoslavia from 1996 to 2001. During this period, Mr. Zetkusic was the Deputy Chief of Mission in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (FRY). The FRY later became Serbia and Montenegro and is not the Republic of Serbia. The records primarily consist of cables that contain observations and reports regarding the escalating conflict in Kosovo.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2019-0894-F Segment 1 are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The collection contains records related to Jack Zetkusic and the former Yugoslavia between 1996 and 2001. During this period, Mr. Zetkusic, a career foreign service officer, served as the Deputy Chief of Mission in the then Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (FRY). The FRY later became Serbia and Montenegro, and is now the Republic of Serbia. During this period, diplomatic relations between the United States and the FRY were strained, and at times non-existent due to ongoing conflict in Kosovo. This collection primarily consists of cables that Mr. Zetkusic helped create. These State Department communications contain observations and reports from 1996 to 2001 regarding the escalating conflict in Kosovo. The majority of the records related to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.
