Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from February 3, 1994, through February 9, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 10) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from February 3, 1994, through February 9, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed. Photographs from February 3, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton addresses students at Kramer Junior High School in Washington, DC. President Clinton takes questions from students at Kramer Junior High School. President Clinton greets Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton, and others on the street outside Kramer Junior High School. President Clinton participates in an interview in the Oval Office with David Neff and Philip Yancey of Christianity Today. President Clinton greets Kim Wardlaw in the Oval Office. President Clinton participates in a briefing in the Oval Office with Bob Kyle, Susan Brophy, and Robert Rubin. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator Kent Conrad, Senator Byron Dorgan, and Representative Earl Pomeroy. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a photo shoot of the residence for a New York Times article. President Clinton participates in a meeting in the Roosevelt Room regarding the end to the

trade embargo on Vietnam. The meeting participants were: General John Shalikashvili, National Security Advisor Tony Lake, Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Les Aspin, Hershel Gober, and others. President Clinton confers in the Outer Oval Office with First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Les Aspin, National Security Advisor Tony Lake, General John Shalikashvili, David Gergen, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Mack McLarty, Josh King, and Nancy Soderberg. President Clinton announces the lifting of the U.S. Trade Embargo on Vietnam in the Roosevelt Room. Seated next to the President is: Secretary Les Aspin, General John Shalikashvili, Secretary Warren Christopher, National Security Advisor Tony Lake, and Hershel Gober. President Clinton greets event participants including Senator Alan Simpson, Senator Bob Kerrey, Senator Charles Robb, Senator Tom Harkin, and others. President Clinton looks at crafts in the Map Room made by artisans for the 1993 White House Christmas decorations. Photographs from February 3, 1994, Continued: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an interview in the Diplomatic Reception Room with Ann Pleshette-Murphy of Parents Magazine. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton walk alone down the hallway to the Family Theatre. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton pose for an official portrait in the White House Library. President Clinton talks alone with Mark Gearan in the White House Library. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
