Summary

This collection contains records regarding Department of Defense Directive (DODD) 5200.27, "Acquisition of Information Concerning Persons and Organizations not Affiliated with the Department of Defense." It contains and unclassified cable from the Department of Defense that lists DODD 5200.27 among the authorities governing intelligence collection and force protection.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0545-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains material regarding Department of Defense Directive (DODD) 5200.27, "Acquisition of Information Concerning Persons and Organizations not Affiliated with the Department of Defense." The current directive, which replaced the version issued in 1975, was issued on January 7, 1980 "to establish for the Defense Investigative Program general policy, limitations, procedures, and operational guidance pertaining to the collecting, processing, storing, and disseminating of information concerning person and organizations not affiliated with the Department of Defense." The collection contains an unclassified cable from the Department of Defense that lists DODD 5200.27 among the authorities governing intelligence collection and force protection.
