Summary

This collection contains materials regarding mail covers. This is an investigative technique in which the postal service records information from the outside of packages or letters and passes it to the law enforcement agency that has requested the mail cover. The records available in this collection consist of two cables that mention the use of mail covers in connection with international law enforcement.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0553-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains records regarding the use of mail covers. Mail covers are an investigative technique in which the postal service records information from the outside of packages or letters and passes it to the law enforcement agency that has requested the mail cover. The records responsive to this FOIA case include an unclassified March 1997 cable on policies in Greece concerning parental child abduction and an unclassified July 2000 cable on United Nations Drug Control Program training in Vietnam. The majority of the records related to this FOIA case are closed for national security reasons.
