Summary

This collection contains systematically processed materials from White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Code CO047. This is the code that WHORM assigned to documents relating to the Czech Republic. The collection consists of correspondence from members of Congress and constituents, as well as correspondence between President Clinton and Czech officials. Of special note is a handwritten letter from Prague-born Secretary of State Madeleine Albright to President Clinton after her 1997 official visit to the city of her birth.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of the material found in WHORM Subject File CO047. This is the code that the White House Office of Records Management assigned to documents relating to the Czech Republic. United States relations with the Central European nation had begun with a formal recognition of Czechoslovakia in 1918. This relationship entered a new phase at the beginning of the Clinton Administration, as the country divided into the two independent nations of the Czech Republic and Slovakia. Throughout the 1990s, U.S. policy in the former focused on supporting the nation as it transitioned away from communism after the Velvet Revolution of 1989, as well its eventual accession to NATO in March 1999. The collection primarily consists of correspondence from members of Congress and constituents regarding U.S. economic and diplomatic cooperation with the Czech Republic. There is also correspondence between President Clinton and both the Czech President and Prime Minister regarding visits, as well as information regarding the customary gifts from the Czech officials. Of special note is a handwritten letter that Prague-born Secretary of State Madeleine Albright sent to President Clinton after her 1997 official visit to the city of her birth, along with a copy of her remarks.
