Summary

This collection contains systematically processed materials from White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Code CO087. This is the code that WHORM assigned to documents relating to Kazakhstan. The collection consists of correspondence related economic cooperation and policy related to U.S.-Kazakhstan relations. The files also contain a copy of the 1994 Charter of Democratic Partnership.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of the material found in WHORM Subject File CO087. This is the code that the White House Office of Records Management assigned to documents relating to Kazakhstan. U.S. relations with the Republic of Kazakhstan began in 1991, when the former became the first nation to extend diplomatic recognition upon the latter's independence from the Soviet Union. Since that time, the two nations have partnered in security, nuclear non-proliferation, and economic investment. The records in this collection primarily consist of correspondence related to Kazakhstan relations and policy. These include correspondence with American corporations, particularly oil companies, regarding economic cooperation as well as letters between President Clinton and Kazakhstani President Nursultan Nazarbayev. A copy of the 1994 Charter of Democratic Partnership is also located in these files.
