Summary

This collection contains systematically processed materials from White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Code CO012. This is the code that WHORM assigned to documents relating to the Republic of Azerbaijan. The collection consists for correspondence, primarily from members of Congress, concerning the ongoing conflict in Nagorno-Karabakh.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of material found in WHORM Subject File CO012. This is the code that the White House Office of Records Management assigned to documents relating to the Republic of Azerbaijan. The United States' formal diplomatic relationship with Azerbaijan began in 1992, after the latter obtained independence from the Soviet Union. Since then, the U.S. has worked with Azerbaijan on issues related to energy security, bilateral investment, democratic reforms, as well as pursuing a resolution to nation's conflict with Armenia over the Nagorno-Karabakh region. The records in this collection consist of correspondence, primarily from members of Congress. These materials concern the ongoing Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, especially as it concerned a ban on aid to Azerbaijan. The correspondence also discusses White House visits in 1997 and 2000 by Azerbaijani President Heydar Aliyev, as well as concerns regarding free and open elections.
