Approximately 2,517 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 2, 1994, through April 4, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 29) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken April 2, 1994, through April 4, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from April 2, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Crown Manor personnel and others prior to departing the residence in Coronado, California. President Clinton greets police, state troopers, volunteers, and others prior to departing from North Island Naval Air Station in San Diego, California for Charlotte, North Carolina. President Clinton stands on the steps of Air Force One holding a basketball with the First Lady. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton disembark Air Force One at Charlotte International Airport in North Carolina. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend the NCAA Final Four Men's Basketball game at Charlotte Coliseum. They watch the University of Arkansas Razorbacks play the University of Arizona Wildcats. President Clinton and the First Lady are accompanied by Chelsea Clinton and her

friend Elizabeth Fleming. The Clintons visit with fans and staff during the game. President Clinton greets Secretary Bruce Babbitt at the game. Staff present at the game include William Itoh, Helen Dickey, Marsha Scott, Bruce Lindsey, and Bill Burton. President Clinton greets police, volunteers, and others on the tarmac at Charlotte International Airport in North Carolina prior to departing for Andrews Air Force Base. President Clinton talks with staff aboard Air Force One during the flight. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton disembark Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from April 3, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton pose for photos on the North Portico on Easter Sunday. The Clinton family arrives at the Foundry United Methodist Church in Washington, D.C. Following Easter church service, the Clintons arrive at Sequoia Restaurant in Georgetown for Easter Brunch. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton play catch in the Rose Garden. The Clintons are preparing for Major League Baseball Opening Day First Pitch Ceremonies. Photographs from April 4, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talk to Robin Dickey, Capricia Marshall, Helen Dickey, and Wayne Skinner in the Blue Room. The Clinton's address the 1994 Photographs from April 4, 1994, Continued: Easter Egg Roll on the South Lawn of the White House. The Clinton's participate in the festivities of the Easter Egg Roll. The Easter Egg Roll activities include a petting zoo, the egg roll, characters in costume such as Easter Bunnies and the Cookie Monster, entertainers, and artists. Attorney General Janet Reno addresses a group of children on one of the stages at the Easter Egg Roll. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with representative from the American Egg Board in the Map Room of the White House. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests at the Easter Egg Roll reception in the Blue Room. Guests include White House Executive Chef Walter Scheib and his family. President Clinton greets Martin family members in the Oval Office. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Associate Sponsors of the Easter Egg Roll in the Diplomatic Reception Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Chicago O'Hare International Airport in Illinois. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Infant Welfare Society of Chicago. The First Lady tours the facility with: Francis Ginther, Executive Director, Linda Meierederas, President of the Board of Directors, Representative Dan Rostenkowski, and Senator Carol Moseley-Braun. The First Lady and others participate in a panel discussion with Dr. Allan Charles, Sharon Green, and Marilyn Turner from Chicago Mayor Daley's Task Force on Women's Health. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Wrigley Field in Chicago. The First Lady

greet Chicago Cubs players in their locker room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets players and U.S. Olympian Bonnie Blair from the front row seats in Wrigley Field. The First Lady throws out the ceremonial first pitch at the Opening Day baseball game between the Chicago Cubs and the New York Mets. The First Lady attends the game with Ernie Banks, Charlie Brumback, Representative Dan Rostenkowski, and others. The First Lady participates in an interview with Walter Jacobsen, WFLD-TV in the press area. The First Lady joins Chicago Cubs radio broadcaster Harry Caray in the WGN-Radio box during the game. The First Lady attends a reception at the Sheffield Grill Restaurant in Chicago following the game.

Photographs from April 4, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at Chicago O'Hare International Airport prior to departing Chicago and traveling to Andrews Air Force Base. President Clinton stands and holds a basketball on the White House North Lawn Driveway. President Clinton talks to reporters and photographers in the press pool outside the Sheraton City Centre Hotel in Cleveland, Ohio. President Clinton attends a reception at the Sheraton City Centre Hotel in Cleveland. President Clinton plays and jokes on a weightlifting machine at the hotel. President Clinton attends the Opening Day baseball game at Jacobs Field in Cleveland. The President is introduced on the field and prepares to throw out the ceremonial first pitch before the Cleveland Indians and Seattle Mariners game. President Clinton watches the game from the Cleveland Indians owner box. President Clinton greets dignitaries and guests at Jacobs Field. President Clinton visits the Cleveland locker room and greets players and staff. President Clinton visits the Cleveland Indians dugout area and greets players including Eddie Murray and others. President Clinton also greets Seattle Mariners Manager Lou Piniella. President Clinton talks to the press pool on the field in Cleveland. President Clinton greets police, state troopers, and others on the tarmac at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport prior to departing for Charlotte, North Carolina. President Clinton arrives at Charlotte International Airport in North Carolina. President Clinton greets City Year representatives on the tarmac. President Clinton arrives at the Charlotte Coliseum to attend the NCAA Championship Men's Basketball game between the University of Arkansas Razorbacks and the Duke University Blue Devils. President Clinton watches the game from a suite and Arkansas wins the National Championship game. President Clinton congratulates Arkansas players including Corliss Williamson in their locker room. President Clinton greets Arkansas coach Nolan Richardson in the Arkansas locker room. President Clinton visits the Duke Blue Devils locker room and greets coach Mike Krzyzewski and players including Christian Laettner, Grant Hill,

Jeff Capel, and others. President Clinton greets Kevin Costner and fans at the game.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
