Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 4, 1994 and April 6, 1994 through April 9, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 31) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 4, 1994 and April 6, 1994 through April 9, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Some images responsive to this case were previously processed in FOIA case # 2006-1268-F. Photographs from April 4, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton speaks to the press pool on the South Lawn prior to departing the White House for Cleveland, Ohio. Also photographed are Jeff Eller and Tony Lake. Photographs from April 6, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton returns from Bowling Green, Kentucky to the South Lawn via Marine One. Also present are Pat Griffin and Mark Gearan. Also photographed is Naval Military Aide Richard Fitzpatrick. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton attend the Royal Ballet's world premiere of Sleeping Beauty at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. The Clintons greet Princess Margaret, Countess of Snowdon,

along with Debi Schiff and Jimmy Schiff. Photographs from April 7, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with members of the Arkansas running club. Photographed includes George Hirsch, Henley Gible, Don Still, Betsey Still, David Samuel, Bonita Samuel, and Lynn Warner. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing in the Oval Office. The President proceeds to an interview in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Photographed includes Jeff Eller, John Hart, Dee Dee Myers, Christine Heenan, and Meeghan Prunty. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Minneapolis Star Tribune editorial board at the Star Tribune Building in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Also photographed includes Dee Dee Myers, John Hart, Meeghan Prunty, Kristie Kenney, Bruce Lindsey, and Andrew Friendly. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests on the South Lawn of the White House. The President departs the White House via Marine One en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President boards Air Force One en route Topeka, Kansas. Photographed includes Carolyn Huber, Milli Alston, Erskine Bowles, Meeghan Prunty, Bob Boorstin, Paul Begala, Jeff Eller, Bruce Lindsey, Lisa Kramer, and Shaunagh Robbins. The President arrives in Topeka, Kansas and participates in a health care event. Present are Representative Jim Slattery and Governor Joan Finney. The President proceeds to the motorcade. George Stephanopoulos and Wendy Smith are present. President William Jefferson Clinton greets people in Topeka, Kansas. The President proceeds to a discussion on health care with small business owners at the Topeka Foundry and Ironworks company. Present includes James Heiman, Sheryl Wohlford, Regina Jaramillo, and Alonzo Harrison, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Hangar 662 Kansas Air National Guard, Topeka Airport. The President greets guests present prior to departing Topeka en route Kansas City, Kansas. The President arrives in Kansas City. The President addresses a local crowd at the Kansas City Downtown Municipal Airport. Following the address, the President discusses health care reform. Also photographed is Governor Mel Carnahan. (April 7, 1994 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a health care town hall meeting at the KCTV Television Station in Kansas City, Kansas. Also photographed is Wendy Smith, George Stephanopoulos, Bob Boorstin, Paul Begala, John Hart, Meeghan Prunty, Bruce Lindsey, and Dee Dee Myers. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests present at Kansas City International Airport. The President departs Kansas City en route Minneapolis, Minnesota. The President arrives at the Marquette Hotel in Minneapolis, Minnesota. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton prepares to start the regional health care satellite tour in Room 459 of the Old Executive Office Building.

The First Lady speaks to KATU-TV, KOIN-TV, WWL-TV, KTRK-TV, KOMO-TV, WPVI-TV, WCAU-TV, WLNE-TV, WPRI-TV, and WJAR-TV. Also photographed are staff in the White House Scheduling Office including Isabelle Tapia, Colleen McCarthy, Stephanie Streett, Sarah Ryan, Grace Garcia, Anne Walley, Ricki Seidman, and Lee Satterfield. Photographs from April 8, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at the Marquette Hotel in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The President confers with staff members. Photographed includes Dee Dee Myers, Kristie Kenney, John Hart, and Bruce Lindsey. The President proceeds to a meet & greet reception at the hotel. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a health care rally in the courtyard of the IDS Tower in Minneapolis, Minnesota. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a town hall meeting titled "Health Care in the Heartland" at the KSTP ABC affiliate station in St. Paul, Minnesota. Prior to the event the President converses with Dee Dee Myers, Bob Boorstin, Meeghan Prunty, John Hart, Wendy Smith, and Andrew Friendly. Photographs from April 9, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address from the Oval Office of the White House. Standing by the Resolute Desk are police officers present. Following the address the President greets guests & staff present including Heather Beckel, Nancy Soderberg, Jeremy Gaines, Josh King, Carol Rasco, Keith Boykin, Carter Wilkie, Wendy Smith, and Gene Sperling, among others.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
