## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 15, 1994 through April 18, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 35) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 15, 1994 through April 18, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Select images responsive to this case were previously processed in FOIA case number 2016-0595-F. Photographs from April 15, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at a reception for the American Society of Newspaper Editors at the White House. Photographs from April 16, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets Trisha Yearwood on West Executive Avenue in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Robert Trent Jones golf club in Gainesville, Virginia. Present includes Jeremy Orchin, Bob Armstrong, and Robert Trent Jones, Jr. Photographs from April 17, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Kingsmill Resort in Williamsburg, Virginia. Present are Thurgood Marshall, Jr., Paul Carey, Senator Byron Dorgan, Senator Daniel Akaka, and Senator Charles Robb.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks to the press on the tarmac prior to departing from Williamsburg, Virginia en route Charlotte, North Carolina. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in the Ford Mustang 30th Anniversary event at the Charlotte Motor Speedway in Charlotte, North Carolina. The President drives his 1967 Ford Mustang convertible down the pit lane of the speedway. The President addresses attendees of the event. Following his address, the President greets Mustang Club of America president Bill Hillard, Ford Motor Company chairman Alex Trotman, and observes Mustangs parked at the event & converses with their owners. The President is presented with a racing helmet signed by forty-two of the current drivers in the NASCAR (National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing) Winston Cup Series. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests present prior to departing Charlotte, North Carolina en route Andrews Air Force Base. Also photographed are Erskine Bowles, Jeff Eller, Nancy Soderberg, Andrew Friendly, and Harold Ickes. Photographs from April 18, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Secretary of Defense William Perry, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, and James Woolsey in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the meeting the President meets in a separate meeting with Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, David Gergen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, and George Stephanopoulos. Following the meeting the President proceeds along the Colonnade with Dee Dee Myers, Tony Lake, George Stephanopoulos, and David Gergen. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks to the press on the South Lawn prior to departing the White House. The President proceeds to Marine One and lands at Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed traveling with the President includes Dee Dee Myers, Kristie Kenney, and Bruce Lindsey. The President arrives at Milwaukee Mitchell Field in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. (April 18, 1993 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Italian Community Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin for an Ameritech event. The President views a demonstration of the Wisconsin health information computer network. The President addresses Ameritech employees. Present include Richard Noteba, Morton Bahr, Mayor John Norquist, Representative Gerald Kleczka, Senator Russell Feingold, and Senator Herb Kohl. Following the event, the President participates in an interview with St. Louis media. After the interview the President proceeds to an event with the Milwaukee Journal editorial board. Later, the President attends a reception at the Italian Community Center. President William Jefferson Clinton visits Leon's Frozen Custard shop in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests prior to departing Milwaukee, Wisconsin en route Andrews Air Force Base. First Lady Hillary Rodham

Clinton arrives at Baltimore Penn Station aboard an Amtrak train in Baltimore, Maryland. The First Lady greets guests present outside the Canton Café. Present are Senator Barbara Mikulski, Representative Benjamin Cardin, and Myrna Cardin. The First Lady participates in a health care discussion at the Canton Café. Following the event the First Lady proceeds to an event at the Omni Inner Harbor. Present are Mayor Kurt Schmoke. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Sarah M. Roach Elementary School in Baltimore, Maryland. The First Lady greets Principal Ann Moore, Representative Kweisi Mfume, and a group of students. The First Lady participates in a meeting at the school. Present are John Walton, Christy Walton, Walter Amprey, John Golle, Mae Gaskins, and Lillian Chung. The First Lady tours a computer lab at the school. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a health care reform event in the Turner Auditorium at John Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland. Present includes Representative Benjamin Cardin, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, and Thelma Daley, among others.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
