Summary

This collection consists of records relating to David Boren, who served as Governor of Oklahoma 1975-1979, and U.S. Senator from Oklahoma between 1979 and 1994. Records in this collection include correspondence from Senator Boren and other senators to the White House regarding foreign and domestic policy decisions, appointment recommendations, event invitations, and requests on behalf of constituents, and focus on topics including the federal budget, oil and gas subsidies, campaign finance reform, tax incentives, and agricultural and water safety concerns.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0915-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Materials responsive to this FOIA request include correspondence from David Boren and other senators to the White House regarding foreign and domestic policy decisions, appointment recommendations, invitations to events, and requests on behalf of constituents visiting Washington, D.C., from Oklahoma. Materials discuss topics including balancing the federal budget, oil and gas subsidies, campaign finance reform, tax incentives, as well as agricultural and water safety concerns. David Boren served as United States Senator from Oklahoma from 1979-1994. Prior to being elected to the U.S. Senate, he was Governor of Oklahoma from 1975-1979 and served in the Oklahoma House of Representatives from 1967-1974. He resigned from the U.S. Senate in 1994 to become President of the University of Oklahoma, a position he held until June 2018.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM (CL), Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
