Summary

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 92) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on September 24, 1994 & September 28, 1994 through October 2, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from September 24, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in Chicago, Illinois. Photographs from September 28, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and President Boris Yeltsin (Борис Николаевич Ельцин) of Russia are photographed during President's Yeltsin's departure from the White House. Photographs from September 29, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., meet with Deputy Prime Minister of Ireland Richard Spring in the Vice President's West Wing office at the White House. Also present include Jack Quinn, Leon Fuerth, and Nancy Soderberg. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff at the Treasury Department regarding the Interstate Banking Bill. Present

includes George Stephanopoulos, Robert Rubin, and Secretary of Labor Robert Reich. The President proceeds to the event for the Interstate Banking Bill signing ceremony. Accompanying the President is Rubin & Lloyd Cutler. The President addresses the ceremony and signs the bill. Also photographed includes Representative Lucille Roybal-Allard, Representative Luis Gutierrez, and Representative Joe Kennedy, among others. The President converses with Alan Greenspan and Thomas "Mack" McLarty on East Executive Avenue. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Stan Greenberg, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Mandy Grunwald, David Dreyer, Tony Coelho, Harold Ickes, Jack Quinn, Pat Griffin, David Wilhelm, Joan Baggett, Ricki Seidman, Doug Sosnik, Billy Webster, Dee Dee Myers, Marcia Hale, John Podesta, Paul Begala, and Mickey Kantor. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, and Mickey Kantor in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding Japan. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Leon Panetta & Tony Lake in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit the Library of Congress. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with the White House Preservation Committee in the Blue Room at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton & Attorney General Janet Reno address the legal services reception at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the National Association of Women Business Owners in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building in Washington, DC. Tony Lake meets with Indonesian diplomats in his office in the West Wing of the White House. Photographs from September 30, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Democratic National Committee labor council in the Map Room at the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Justice Department in Washington, DC for the swearing in ceremony of Stephen Breyer as Supreme Court Justice. The President greets the other Justices and participates in a group photograph opportunity. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Representative Ronald Coleman in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the meeting the President proceeds to the Roosevelt Room to record his weekly radio address. The President greets guests present. Following the radio address, the President returns to the Oval Office where he greets a German health care group & health care task force staff in separate meetings. The President also participates in a group photograph opportunity with both groups separately. President William Jefferson Clinton signs appropriations bills

in the Oval Office of the White House. Present include Senator Robert Byrd, Representative David Obey, Leon Panetta, and Pat Griffin. President William Jefferson Clinton greets regional police chiefs in the Oval Office of the White House. Present is Lew Merletti. Following the event the President greets departing military personnel. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a scheduling meeting in the Oval Office of the White House. Photographed include Billy Webster, George Stephanopoulos, Ricki Seidman, Tony Coelho, Harold Ickes, and Joan Baggett. President William Jefferson Clinton & Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., proceed to Blair House for a meeting with members of cabinet. Photographed include Christine Varney, Benedicte Valentiner, Laura Tyson, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, John Deutch, Secretary of Energy Hazel O'Leary, Attorney General Janet Reno, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Phil Lader, Carol Browner, Mickey Kantor, Alice Rivlin, Secretary of Veterans Affairs Jesse Brown, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Secretary of Transportation Federico Peña, Leon Panetta, and Harold Ickes, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding Haiti. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Tony Lake, John Deutch, Leon Panetta, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Leon Fuerth, James Woolsey, David Gergen, Ambassador William Gray, and Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown. Following the meeting the President confers with staff in the Oval Office. Also photographed is Deutch speaking with Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a radio interview in the Cabinet Room of the White House with Alan Colmes & Felicia Knight. Present includes George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, and Richard Stauss. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a radio interview. Also present is Richard Strauss. Photographs from October 1, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Robert Trent Jones golf course in Manassas, Virginia. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and proceeds to the Hilton Hotel. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates at an event for senior citizens at Sunrise Lakes in Sunrise, Florida. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview in Hollywood, Florida. Photographs from October 2, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed outside of the Foundry United Methodist church in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton & Chelsea Clinton visit the Hirshhorn Sculpture Garden outside the Hirshhorn Museum in Washington, DC. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the congregation at the Baptist church in Saint Petersburg, Florida.
