Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 4, 1994 through October 6, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 94) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 4, 1994 through October 6, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs responsive to this segment were previously processed in FOIA case number 2021-0654-F. Photographs from October 4, 1994 are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton escorts the press pool to the East Room of the White House to see the table settings for the upcoming state dinner for President Nelson Mandela. Present is White House chef Walter Scheib, Ann Stock, Robyn Dickey, Nancy Clarke, and Lisa Caputo. White House kitchen staff prepares for the upcoming state dinner for President Nelson Mandela in the White House Mess. Photographs from October 5, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with President Nelson Mandela of South Africa in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. Secretary of State Warren Christopher, and Tony Lake.

President Mandela individually greets Betty Currie, Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, and Andrew Friendly. President Clinton & President Mandela converse alone, and later walk along the Colonnade. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Oval Office prior to the President's press conference with President Nelson Mandela. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, Mark Gearan, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos. Also photographed is Andrew Friendly standing next to the door to the Oval Office from the Colonnade. President William Jefferson Clinton attends a luncheon in the East Room of the White House with President Nelson Mandela. Present includes First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Zindiswa Mandela-Hlongwane, among others. Also photographed includes Molly Raiser, White House kitchen staff and White House butler staff. President Mandela addresses the luncheon and later greets White House butlers. Also photographed is the table settings for the luncheon prior to the event. President William Jefferson Clinton and President Nelson Mandela participate in a joint press conference on the South Lawn of the White House. Prior to the press conference President Clinton and President Mandela converse in the Diplomatic Reception Room. Following the press conference President Mandela departs the White House from the South Portico. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with President Boris Yeltsin of Russia. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with AmeriCorps supporters in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Eli Segal, Anne Wexler, Nicole Rodham, Stew Boxer, Tim Boggs, Harris Wofford, and Senator Jay Rockefeller, among others. Also photographed is First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaking on the telephone in the Outer Oval Office and President Clinton greeting Jim Brady in the Oval Office in a separate meeting. President William Jefferson Clinton and President Nelson Mandela address a reception at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington, DC, for the African Prize for Leadership for the Sustainable End of Hunger. Photographed on the dais is Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, among others. (Photographs from October 5, 1994 Continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Senator George Mitchell Scholarship Dinner at the Hyatt Regency Washington Hotel in Washington, DC. Present includes Senator George Mitchell, Senator Richard Gephardt, Representative Tom Foley, and Representative Robert Michel Miscellaneous photographs including Kelly Crawford, Nancy Hernreich, Heather Beckel, Betty Currie, and Andrew Friendly in the Outer Oval Office of the White House. Photographs from October 6, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton

crosses the South Lawn of the White House prior to departing en route Norfolk, Virginia. Photographed includes Bruce Lindsey, Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers, and Tony Lake. Later the President is photographed boarding Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Norfolk Naval Air Station in Norfolk, Virginia. The President is accompanied by Secretary of Defense William Perry and Tony Lake. Also present is Admiral Paul David Miller. Later the President addresses United States Navy personnel and their families at the Norfolk Naval Air Station. Rear Admiral Paul Moses introduces the President. Prior to the event the President confers with Secretary of Defense William Perry, Tony Lake, and Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers in a holding room. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses United States Navy personnel aboard the USS Eisenhower. Present includes Secretary of Defense William Perry and Admiral Paul David Miller, among others. The President stands in front of a large American flag and a Grumman F-14 Tomcat. President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed at Andrews Air Force Base returning from Norfolk, Virginia. Air Force One and Marine One are in the background. Also photographed is the President walking along the South Lawn landing zone at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the National Education Association in Washington, DC. The First Lady greets guests prior to the remarks and is later introduced by Howard Wolpe. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the Democratic National Committee Women’s Leadership Forum at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington, DC. Also present for the event includes Mary Elizabeth “Tipper” Gore, Queen Noor Al Hussein (الملكة نور الحسين), and David Wilhelm, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton is photographed at the White House. The First Lady converses with Loretta Avent, walks down a hallway with Ann Stock, and speaks with Lu Hardin & Mary Hardin on the South Portico.

Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
