Summary

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 95) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken October 4, 1994; October 6, 1994, through October 9, 1994. Select photo contact sheets from October 4 & 6-7, 1994, were previously processed in cases 2016-0871-F, 2020-0378-F, and 2021-0645-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets. The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from October 4, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets with Black U.S. Mayors in the Roosevelt Room. Photographs from October 6, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet and meet with Heather Whitestone, Miss America in the Oval Office. Carol Rasco is present at the meeting. President Clinton and Prime Minister Chuan Leekpai of Thailand address the U.S. Thailand Business Council in the Roosevelt Room. President Clinton talks in the West Wing hallway area with Secretary Warren Christopher, Sady Berger, and others following the event. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Chuan of Thailand. Meeting participants include Secretary Warren Christopher and Sandy Berger. President Clinton greets National Security Council staff in the West

Wing hallway area following the meeting. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Loretta Avent in the Ground Floor residence hallway area. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a National Education Association event in Washington, D.C. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Tipper Gore depart the White House for a Women's Leadership Forum event in Washington. President Clinton returns to the White House and greets Lu Hardin, Mary Hardin, Bev Lindsey, and others at the South Grounds and South Portico area. President Clinton talks to the Hardin's Bruce Lindsey, Bev Lindsey, Carolyn Huber in the Ground Floor residence hallway area. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Old Executive Office Building (EOB) with Union leaders regarding health care. Photographs from October 6, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a meeting in the Map Room with Heather Whitestone, Miss America. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the League of United Latin American Citizens at the Hotel Washington. Participants include Ada Pena, Larry Tejor, and Representative Lucille Roybal-Allard. Photographs from October 7, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging with Lu Hardin near the Tidal Basin in Washington. President Clinton poses for a group photo in the Rose Garden with the U.S. Coast Guard Academy football team. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Foreign Minister Farouk Al-Shara of Syria. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, and Dennis Ross. President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office (Photos are taken through the doorway from the Rose Garden). President Clinton talks alone to Andrew Friendly in the Oval Office. President Clinton addresses the Blue Ribbon Teachers event on the South Lawn. Event participants include Vice President Albert Gore and Secretary Richard Riley. President Clinton greets ceremony guests. The President walks along the White House Colonnade with Leon Panetta. Photographs from October 7, 1994, Continued: President Clinton confers with Leon Panetta, Gene Sperling, Don Steinberg, Mark Gearan, Dee Dee Myers, David Dreyer, and George Stephanopoulos in the Blue Room prior to his press conference. President Clinton delivers a press conference in the East Room. The President takes questions from reporters. President Clinton greets President Nelson Mandela of South Africa at the South Portico. President Clinton talks to Molly Raiser in the Diplomatic Reception Room. President Clinton and President Mandela deliver a joint radio address in the

East Room. President Clinton and President Mandela greet children and others following the address. President Mandela greet White House staff members including Richard Strauss, Neel Lattimore, Karen Finney, and others. President Clinton walks on the South Grounds with Don Steinberg. President Clinton confers with Mark Gearan and Dawn Alexander in the Oval Office prior to his interview with USA Today. President Clinton participates om an interview and photo shoot with USA Today Weekend on the Colonnade. President Clinton participates in radio interview with Ellen Ratner in the Oval Office. President Clinton walks on the Colonnade with Dee Dee Myers and George Stephanopoulos. President Clinton bids goodbye to President Nelson Mandela at the South Portico. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Tony Knowles and his spouse Susan Morris. President Clinton goes jogging with former Hot Springs, Arkansas High School classmates in Washington. President Clinton greets tourists through the White House gate. President Clinton and his former classmates play football on the South Lawn. President Clinton and his high school friends visit in the Oval Office. Loretta Avent and a group of Native Americans pose for a group photo in front of the North Portico. President Clinton reads papers on his desk and talks with Richard Strauss and Mark Gearan in the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Memphis International Airport. The First Lady is accompanied by Melanne Verveer, Lisa Caputo, and Kelly Craighead. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at St. Jude Children's Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee. The First Lady is greeted by Marlo Thomas, Tony Thomas, Terre Thomas, and Dr. Arthur Nienhuis. The First Lady greets children and tours the hospital. The First Lady participates in the dedication of the Patient Care Center. The First Lady, Marlo Thomas, Phil Donahue, Tony Thomas, and Terre Thomas participate in the ribbon cutting ceremony. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with the Commercial Appeal Editorial Board at the Commercial Appeal headquarters in Memphis. President Clinton meets with President Vigdís Finnbogadóttir of Iceland in the Oval Office. Photographs from October 8, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton greets actor Michael J. Fox and his son in the Oval Office. George Stephanopoulos and Dee Dee Myers are present. President Clinton walks on the South Lawn driveway with Tony Lake. President Clinton talks to the press pool regarding Iraq. The Clintons talk to Gary Walters in the Rose Garden. The President and the First Lady walk to Marine One on the South Lawn and depart to Camp David. Photographs from October 9, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, and friend disembark Marine One on the South Lawn on their return from Camp David. Views of sculptures in the Jacqueline Kennedy Garden and Foyer

area at the White House. The Clintons greet the installers of the works of art. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
