Approximately 2,026 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 104) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken October 28, 1994, through November 1, 1994. A significant amount of photo contact sheets in this segment from October 28, 1994, through October 31, 1994, were previously processed in cases 2016-0242-F, 2022-0238-F, and 2023-0520-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from October 28, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets an Armenian group at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel in Los Angeles, California. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the Hollywood Women's Political Committee luncheon in Los Angeles. Event participants include Barbara Streisand, Whoopi Goldberg, Chaka Khan, Julia Louis Dreyfuss, Marlee Matlin, and others. Photographs from October 29, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at the Los Angeles airport prior to departing for her flight to San Francisco, California. President Clinton talks with Leon Panetta in the residence regarding a man who shot at the White House. President Clinton watches news coverage on

television in his residence bedroom. Views of bullet marks on the North Portico side of the White House. The shooter was later identified as Francisco Martin Duran. According to news reports at least 29 shots from a semiautomatic rifle were fired at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives in San Francisco and is met by Mayor Frank Jordan. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the Women's Vote Project Rally at the Palace for Fine Arts Theatre in San Francisco. Event participants include Senator Dianne Feinstein, Kathleen Brown, Helen Hunt, Representative Nancy Pelosi, Ellen Malcolm, and Senator Patty Murray. The First Lady confers with Lisa Caputo, Melanne Vermeer, and others in the holding room at the theatre. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets police and others at the airport prior to departing San Francisco. Photographs from October 29, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives in Sacramento, California and is met by Mayor Joe Serna. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a fundraiser for Senator Dianne Feinstein in Sacramento. The First Lady greets people at the airport prior to departing Sacramento. President Clinton addresses the Italian American Foundation dinner at the Washington Hilton in the District of Columbia. Event participants include Jack Valenti, Isabella Rossellini, Senator Patrick Leahy, and others. Photographs from October 30, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests at a reception for Ford's Theatre in the Blue Room of the White House. Guests include Senator David Pryor, Mack McLarty, Donna McLarty, Phil Lader, Linda Lader, Kenny G, Representative Henry Waxman, General Colin Powell, Paul Reiser, and others. Photographs from October 31, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton confers in the Oval Office Dining Room with Mandy Grunwald, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Harold Ickes, Andrew Friendly, and others. President Clinton talks in the Oval Office with Leon Panetta, Andrew Friendly, and others. President Clinton and Leon Panetta talk alone as they walk to the Presidential Limousine on the South Grounds of the White House. President Clinton participates in the "California Desert Protection Act" bill signing ceremony in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets Hispanic appointees from his administration in the Oval Office. White House Mess personnel pose for a group photo with a giant carved pumpkin. President Clinton confers in the Oval Office with Leon Panetta and Pat Griffin. Nancy Hrenreich and Andrew Friendly are present in the Oval Office. Photographs from October 31, 1994, Continued: President Clinton talks on the telephone and consults with Bruce Lindsey and Paul Begala. The location is not identified. President Clinton arrives at the 911th Tactical Air Wing, Air

Force Reserve Base in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. President Clinton addresses a rally in Pittsburgh for Senator Harris Wofford and Lieutenant Governor Mark Stephen Singel. The President greets guests including police officers at a reception following the rally in the David Lawrence Convention Center. President Clinton greets people on the tarmac at the Air Force Reserve Base prior to departing Pittsburgh. President Clinton arrives at Philadelphia International Airport and greets people on the tarmac. President Clinton addresses a rally at City Hall in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Rally participants include John Streett, City Council President, Senator Harris Wofford, Mayor Ed Rendell, and L Lieutenant Governor Mark Stephen Singel. The President attends a reception in the Mayor's Office and greets guests. President Clinton departs Philadelphia International Airport Photographs from November 1, 1994, are as follows: Major Michael Mudd and Colonel Rusty Schorsch walk away from Marine One on the South Lawn. President Clinton crosses the South Lawn with Bruce Lindsey and Harold Ickes prior to departing on Marine One for a trip to Detroit, Michigan. President Clinton arrives at Willow Run Airport in Detroit. President Clinton is in route to the University of Michigan at Dearborn. President Clinton attends a roundtable discussion on Student Loan Programs at the University of Michigan Student Union in Dearborn. Photographs from November 1, 1994, Continued: President Clinton addresses a rally at the Cobo Convention Center in Detroit. Rally participants include Mayor Dennis Archer, Ed Macnamara, Wayne County Commissioner, Representative Bob Carr, and others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits Benning Elementary School in Washington, D.C. The First Lady is met at the school by Tom Ryder, American Express, Bill Shore, Founder and Executive Director Share Our Strength, Geneva Williams, Principal, and Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton. The First Lady participates in a satellite feed with sites in Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, and New York in the elementary school media room. The First Lady participates in a "Charge Against Hunger" breakfast in the elementary school cafeteria. Wes Unseld from the Washington Bullets NBA team, participates with the First Lady. The First Lady announces the Washington Grand Prize Poster contest winners with the school.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
