Summary

This collection contains systematically processed materials from White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Code CO021. This is the code that WHORM assigned to documents relating to the Kingdom of Bhutan. The collection consists of a January 1998 letter from President Clinton to King Jigme Singye Wangchuck to thank him for welcoming Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala during her visit to the Kingdom.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials found in WHORM Subject Code CO021. This is the code that the White House Office of Records Management assigned to documents relating to the Kingdom of Bhutan. Although Bhutan and the United States have never established formal diplomatic relations, the two countries maintain warm, informal relations via their diplomatic missions at the United Nations. During the Clinton Administration, Jigme Singye Wangchuck was the king, or Druk Gyalpo, of Bhutan. The collection consists of a January 1998 letter from President Clinton to King Jigme Singye to thank him for welcoming Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala during her visit to the Kingdom.
