Summary

This collection contains systematically processed materials from White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Code CO026. This is the code that WHORM assigned to documents relating to Brunei Darussalam, a Malay Muslim monarchy in Southeast Asia. The collection consists of two thank you letters from President Clinton to Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah ibni Omar Ali Saifuddien III. The first, from February 2000, is for a holiday gift hamper. The second, from January 2001, responds to the APEC meeting in November 2000 and thanks the Sultan for the gifts presented to the Clintons during their visit.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials found in WHORM Subject Code CO026. This is the code that the White House Office of Records Management assigned to documents relating to Brunei, a Malay Muslim monarchy in Southeast Asia. The relationship between United States and Brunei Darussalam began with the Treaty of Peace, Friendship, Commerce and Navigation in 1850, which remains in effect. The two nations established formal diplomatic relations in 1984 upon Brunei's full independence from the United Kingdom. In 1994, the United States and Brunei signed a memorandum of understanding on defense cooperation. Both countries are founding members of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC), and Brunei hosted the annual meeting in November 2000. Haji Hassanal Bolkiah ibni Omar Ali Saifuddien III has been Sultan of Brunei since 1967. The collection contains two thank you letters from President Clinton to the Sultan. The first, from February 2000, is for a holiday gift hamper. The second, from January 2001, responds to the APEC meeting in November 2000 and thanks the Sultan for the gifts presented to the Clintons during their visit. Along with the drafts of this second letter, there are a

number of publications from the APEC 2000.
