## **Summary**

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 42) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 3, 1994 through May 5, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Images responsive to this segment was previously processed in FOIA case 2023-0675-F. Photographs from May 3, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Dobbins Air Force Base in Atlanta, Georgia. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Jimmy Carter Presidential Library in Atlanta, Georgia. The President is met by former President Jimmy Carter, Governor Zell Miller, and Maynard Jackson, among others. President Clinton and President Carter meet in a one-on-one. Present also are George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Wendy Smith, and Stephen Goodin. President Clinton drops by a meeting with the Carter Fellows prior to proceeding to the CNN World Report Contributors' Conference. President William Jefferson Clinton

participates in a staff briefing prior to proceeding to the CNN World Report Contributors' Conference in Atlanta, Georgia. Present includes Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, George Stephanopoulos, and David Gergen, among others. The President proceeds to the conference in the Cecil B. Day Chapel at the Carter Presidential Library. The event is moderated by Judy Woodruff. President William Jefferson Clinton attends a rally at the CNN Center in Atlanta, Georgia. Mayor Bill Cambell is present. Following the rally the President meets with Ted Turner and tours the CNN studios. The President speaks to press in the newsroom. Also present are Jane Fonda and Representative John Lewis. President William Jefferson Clinton greets police present prior to departing Dobbins Air Force Base in Atlanta, Georgia. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at LaGuardia Airport in New York City, New York. The First Lady greets Susan Baek. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the New York Hilton in New York City, New York. The First Lady is met by Colin Greer (President; New World Foundation) and Kara McGuire. Also present are Capricia Marshall, Susan Thomases, Lisa Caputo, and Melanne Verveer. The First Lady participates in the Harold C. Fleming award ceremony in the Grand Ballroom. Present includes Colin Greer, James Joseph, David Harrison, and awardee Henry Hampton. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in various meetings at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel in New York City, New York. The events include meeting with labor leaders, meeting with fashion consultants from Saks Fifth Avenue, and greeting Mandy Dibernardo. Later the First Lady greets Anna Quindlen of the New York Times. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with the ABC editorial board at 47 West 66th Street in New York City, New York. Present include Peter Jennings, Barbara Walters, Roone Arledge, Diane Sawyer, and Lisa Caputo, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with the CBS editorial board at 530 West 57th Street in New York City, New York. Present includes Dan Rather, Mike Wallace, Paula Zahn, and Harry Smith, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with the NBC editorial board at 30 Rockefeller Plaza in New York City, New York. Present includes Katie Couric, Jane Pauley, Lisa Caputo, and Melanne Verveer, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs LaGuardia Airport in New York City, New York en route Andrews Air Force Base. Also present are Lisa Caputo and Melanne Verveer. Photographs from May 4, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office to Chairman Yasser Arafat of the Palestinian Liberation Organization and Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel in separate phone calls in the Oval Office. The President speaks to both Chairman Arafat and Prime Minister Rabin about the agreement regarding Palestinian self-rule

in Jericho in the West Bank and Gaza Strip. President William Jefferson Clinton signs HR 821 in the Oval Office. Senator Daniel Akaka and Representative Henry Bonilla are present, among others. Following the signing the President meets with William Ide. Joel Klein is present, among others. Later the President greets Peggy Heard and a group. The President proceeds to the Outer Oval Office. Present are Betty Currie, Vernon Jordon, George Stephanopoulos, Nancy Hennreich, and Paul Richard. President William Jefferson Clinton walks along the Colonnade with Tony Lake. The President greets Senator George Mitchell and a group. President William Jefferson Clinton drops by a police event in the Indian Treaty Room of the White House. Present is Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros. Prior to the event, the President meets with staff including Mark Gearan, Jonathan Prince, and Josh King, and also greets Mildred Hill. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., meet with members of Congress at the White House. Present includes Representative Nita Lowey, Representative Cynthia McKinney, Representative Nydia Velazquez, Representative Pat Schroeder, Representative Cardiss Collins, Representative Patsy Mink, Representative Lynn Schenk, Susan Brophy, and Ira Magaziner. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a School to Work event on the South Lawn of the White House. Present includes Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Senator Ted Kennedy, Senator Harris Wofford, Senator Paul Simon, Senator Claiborne Pell, Senator Howard Metzenbaum, Senator Mark Hatfield, Senator Lauch Faircloth, Senator James Jeffords, and Senator Dave Durenberger, among others. Student Chris Brady introduces the President prior to his remarks. Prior to the event, the President and First Lady meet with staff in the Map Room. Present include Michael Waldman, Secretary Riley, and Secretary Reich. The President and First Lady proceed to the Diplomatic Reception Room and greet guests prior to the event. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of Congress at the White House. Present includes Senator Tom Daschle, Senator Wendell Ford, Senator Christopher Dodd, Senator Paul Simon, Senator Frank Lautenberg, Senator Ernest Hollings, Senator J. Bennett Johnston, Senator J. James Exon, Senator John Breaux, Senator Harry Reid, Senator Barbara Boxer, Senator Byron Dorgan, Senator Kent Conrad, George Stephanopoulos, Gene Sperling, Alice Rivlin, Pat Griffin, Susan Brophy, Leon Panetta, and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., among others. The President is briefed in the Oval Office prior to the event. President William Jefferson Clinton announces the Small Business of the Year winners in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building. The President confers with

Erskine Bowles, Mark Gearan, and Jonathan Price. President William Jefferson Clinton attends an event at the Washington Court Hotel. Present are Governor Ann Richards, Joe O'Neill, and Secretary of Treasury Lloyd Bentsen. The President departs the hotel en route the Andrew W. Mellon dinner. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend the Andrew W. Mellon dinner at the National Gallery of Art in Washington, DC. Present includes Robert Smith (President of the National Gallery of Art), Earl Powell III (Director of the National Gallery of Art), John Stevenson, Vernon Jordan, and Ann Jordan, among others. The President and First Lady tour the American Portraits gallery. The President addresses the dinner. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a health care event. The First Lady is presented with books from Senator Ted Kennedy. Also present are Senator Chris Dodd, Senator Harris Wofford, and Senator George Mitchell. Present at the health care event include Arthur Flemming (Chairman of HealthRight) and Senator James Jeffords, among others. Photographs from May 5, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed on the South Grounds of the White House following his morning jog. Later the President proceeds to a health care breakfast with American Indian leaders. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with Nelson Mandela. The President congratulates Mandela on his election victory as the first black President of South Africa. Staff present includes Nancy Soderberg, Don Steinberg, Ernest Wilson, and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a statement on the passage of a house ban on assault weapons. Present is Representative Stephen Neal. Prior to the event the President confers with Dee Dee Myers and an unidentified individual on the Colonnade. Also photographed is Debi Schiff looking out a window. President William Jefferson meets with representatives from Mother's Voice, among them group President Ivy Duneier. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a Working Women Count event. Present includes Alexis Herman, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Karen Nussbaum, Linda Lavin, and Valerie Harper. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Maggie Williams greet Gwendolyn Brooks, Henry Blakely, Nora Blakely, and Sheldon Hackney in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
