Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 5, 1994, through May 9, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 43) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken May 5, 1994, through May 9, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from May 5, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a "Working Women Count" event in room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building (EOB). Event participants include Alexis Herman, Secretary Robert Reich, Karen Nussbaum, Linda Lavin, and Valerie Harper. The participants hold up a sign that reads: "Working Women Count! Women's Bureau of the U.S. Department of Labor." First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview with Susan Dentzer of U.S. News and World Report in room 459 of the EOB. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview with Ofra Bickel, Frontline Project, on the Wellesley Class of 1969 in room 459 of the EOB. Pena, and members of the Congressional Hispanic Caucus. President Clinton addresses the event. President Clinton watches the House vote on the Assault Weapons Ban on the television in the Outer Oval Office and in the Oval Office Study. President Clinton celebrates the bill's passage with staff including Rahm Emanuel, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, and others. President Clinton talks with Pat Griffin, Harold Ickes, Stan Greenberg, and others in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton walks alone on the White House Colonnade to the Rose Garden to deliver a statement to the press and staff. President Clinton meets with David Wilhelm, Chairmen of the Democratic National Committee, in the Oval Office. Participants include Mack McLarty, Joan Baggett, and Harold Ickes. Carolyn Lukensmeyer works in her office in the West Wing. President Clinton talks with Vicki Radd, Stan Greenberg, and Josh King in the Outer Oval Office. The President also talks with Pat Griffin, David Gergen, Vicki Radd, Marcia Hale, Harold Ickes, and others in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton greets departing military personnel in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets a group from Arkansas in the Oval Office. Photographs from May 5, 1994, Continued: Kaki Hockersmith and guest pose for photographs in front of the Willem de Kooning painting in the residence. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton appears on the "Larry King Live" television show at CNN in Washington, D.C. The First Lady laughs and jokes with Larry King. Photographs from May 6, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton jogs on the National Mall near the Washington Monument in Washington, D.C. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends and addresses the Navy Nurse Corps Conference at the Sheraton Premiere Hotel in Tysons Corner, Virginia. Conference attendees include Secretary John Dalton and other Navy personnel. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Tipper Gore, Mike Lux, and Alexis Herman in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Don Baer, Bob Boorstin, Mark Gearan, and others regarding health care. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office prior to his meeting with Prime Minister Mahatir of Malaysia with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, John Stern Wolf, U.S. Ambassador to Malaysia, Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, Robert Rubin, Sandy Berger, George Stephanopoulos, and others. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Mahatir of Malaysia. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, and others. President Clinton greets Dick Herget in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets departing U.S. Secret Service agents and their families in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets Office of Personnel Management Merit Award winning employees in the Oval Office. Photographs from May 6, 1994, Continued: President Clinton greets the Science Professor of the Year Dr. Vincente Domingo Villas, Professor of Biology at Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas in the Oval Office. President Clinton congratulates the NCAA Champions Lake Superior University hockey team in the Rose Garden. President Clinton is presented with a hockey sweater by the team at the ceremony. President Clinton greets Gary Walters and a departing residence staff member in the Oval Office. Mack McLarty meets with actress Dana Delaney and Darius Anderson in the White House. Photographs from May 9, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Tsutomu Hata of Japan. President Clinton greets staff and guests and members of the Arkansas Chamber of Congress on the South Lawn prior to departing the White House for a trip to New York City. Views of Marine One taking off towards the Washington Monument. President Clinton arrives at John F. Kennedy International Airport in New York City. Views of a Marine helicopter flying over New York City. President Clinton visits a Pathmark store in New York City. The President walks down the aisles of the store and participates in an event for the store employees. President Clinton arrives at Green State Airport in Providence, Rhode Island. President Clinton addresses a ceremony at the airport. President Clinton is joined on dais by Senator Claiborne Pell, Representative Jack Reed, and Governor Bruce Sundlun. President Clinton participates in a "Ten Town Hall" meeting at WJAR-TV in Providence.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
