Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 20, 1994 through May 21, 1994, and May 23, 1994 through May 25, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 48) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 20, 1994 through May 21, 1994, and May 23, 1994 through May 25, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from May 20, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton deliver a statement on the death of First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis. Following the statements the Clintons walk to Marine One on the South Lawn, en route San Bernardino, California. President William Jefferson Clinton disembarks Air Force One at San Bernardino International Airport. The President delivers remarks to guests present including the 63rd Air Expeditionary Wing. Also photographed includes Secretary of the Air Force Sheila Widnall, Jerry Eaves, Representative Jerry Lewis, Representative George Brown, Senator Barbara Boxer, and Senator Dianne Feinstein. Following his remarks,

the President greets guests present at the event. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at UCLA for the 75th Anniversary Convocation. The President delivers the keynote address. Photographed includes Charles E. Young (Chancellor; UCLA), Jack W. Peltason (President; UCLA), Mayor Richard Riordan, Carole Goldberg-Ambrose, Kate Anderson, Khosrow Khosravani, and Harold Shapiro, among others. Following his remarks, the President greets students and university officials. Later the President is photographed with Dee Dee Myers and greets her family. Photographs from May 21, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at McClellan Air Force Base in Sacramento County, California. The President greets Major General John Phillips, Mayor Joe Serna, Jr., Representative Vic Fazio, and Representative Robert Matsui. The President reviews the honor flight and signs a proclamation. Also photographed is Senator Dianne Feinstein and Secretary of the Air Force Sheila Widnall. The President sits in a Horlacher AG electric vehicle. President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at the Riviera Country Club in Santa Monica, California. Present includes Mayor Richard Riordan, Peter Falk, Marv Adelson, and Charles Young, among others. Also photographed is media present. President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed in front of the home of Angelo Tsakopoulos prior to departing Sacramento, California. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests on the tarmac at Los Angeles International Airport, including Jeremy Gaines. The President departs en route McClellan Air Force Base. The President converses with Senator Dianne Feinstein, among others. Later the President departs McClellan Air Force Base en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from May 23, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Secretary of the Interior Bruce Babbitt in the Red Room of the White House. Joining them is First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Phil Caplan, and Sarah Ryan. The President and First Lady participate in an event to kick off National Park Week and to recognize recipients of the National Park Foundation's leadership award. Among the recipients include Dade County public schools, Everglades National Park, Friends of Meridian Hill, Richard Gale, Elizabeth Barlow Rogers, and Laurence W. Lane. (Photographs from May 23, 1994 continued): President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding the upcoming D-Day ceremonies in France. Present are Secretary of Defense William Perry, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, David Gergen, Ricki Seidman, Dee Dee Myers, Nancy Soderberg, Will Itoh, Jenonne Walker, Jeremy Rosner, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Tony Lake, and Don Baer, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a foreign policy meeting in the

Cabinet Room at the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, David Gergen, Robert Rubin, George Stephanopoulos, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Tony Lake, Pat Griffin, Leon Fuerth, and Bowman Cutter. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with President Abdou Diouf of Senegal in the Oval Office of the White House. Also photographed includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, and Tony Lake. Prior to the meeting the President converses with Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, Tony Lake, and Don Steinberg. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Herschel Walker, Cindy DeAngelis Grossman, and representatives from Franklin Sports. Also present is Betty Currie. Later the President and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speak with Kelly Craighead, Capricia Marshall, Dee Dee Myers, Tony Rodham, and Nicole Boxer. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet members of the Kennedy family at Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia. The Clintons and Kennedys attend the funeral of Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis. Present includes John Kennedy, Jr., Caroline Kennedy Schlossberg, Edwin Schlossberg, Ethel Kennedy, Senator Ted Kennedy, Patrick Kennedy, Representative Joe Kennedy, and Maurice Tempelsman, among others. Photographs from May 24, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on The Mall in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House regarding personnel. Present includes Veronica Biggins and Thomas "Mack" McLarty, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a welfare reform meeting at the White House. Present includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Kathi Way, Leon Panetta, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton greets individuals separately in the Oval Office of the White House, including Pat Parisi, Governor Brendan Byrne, Niko Toutenhoufd, and Michael Mandelbaum. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with President Guntis Ulmanis of Latvia in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Nicholas Burns. (Photographs from May 24, 1994 continued): President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office of the White House with Prime Minister Tsutomu Hata (田中 首相) of Japan. Present are Mickey Kantor, Charlene Barshefsky, Bowman Cutter, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Jim Reed. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding the President's schedule during the commemoration of D-Day in France. Present includes General Claude Kicklighter,

David Gergen, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Jeremy Rosner, Don Baer, Will Itoh, Jenonne Walker, Nancy Soderberg, Tony Lake, and Ricki Seidman, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an expanded briefing with D-Day historians and military personnel in the Family Theatre of the White House in preparation for the President's trip to France for D-Day commemoration ceremonies. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Representative Sam Gibbons, Major General Adrian St. John, Senator Terry Sanford, General Andrew Goodpaster, Kenneth Bargmann, Forrest Pogue, Steven Ambrose, Brigadier General Hal Nelson, John Eisenhower, Paul Fussell, General Claude Kicklighter, Carlo D'Este, John Keegan, Lloyd Cutler, Nancy Soderberg, Robert Bell, Tony Lake, David Gergen, Mark Gearan, Dee Dee Myers, Ricki Seidman, George Stephanopoulos, Don Baer, Jeremy Rosner, and Tom Ross. The President proceeds to the Family Dining Room following the briefing. The President presents Representative Gibbons with two beers, as tribute to Representative Gibbons parachuting into France on D-Day carrying two beers. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at LaGuardia Airport in Queens, New York. The First Lady proceeds to the Waldorf Astoria Hotel and participates in a meeting with columnists. Present includes Liz Smith, Kelly Craighead, Melanne Verveer, and Lisa Caputo. Following the meeting the First Lady proceeds to a health care briefing with women's magazine publishers. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the New York Times in New York. Present is Arthur O. Sulzberger (Chairman & CEO, New York Times). First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets members of the board of The Partnership for a Drug Free America at the New York Hilton in New York. The First Lady addresses an event. Present include James Burke, Thomas A. Hedrick, Jr., Doria Steedman, Allen Rosenshine, and the Brooklyn Youth Chorus. Photographs from May 25, 1994 are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets students in the White House. Also photographed is the First Lady with artwork hanging in the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the International Women's Media Foundation at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC. Present includes Barbara Cochran, Kathy Bushkin, and Judy Woodruff.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
