Summary

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 49) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken May 24, 1994, through May 27, 1994. Several photo contact sheets in this segment were previously processed in cases 2017-0510-F & 2021-0647-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from May 24, 1994, are as follows: Members of the Cabinet and Staff, including Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Secretary Ron Brown, Alan Blinder, Leon Panetta, Secretary Robert Reich, Mickey Kantor, Gene Sperling, and others meet in the Roosevelt Room. President Clinton meets in the White House Situation Room with Tony Lake, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Madeleine Albright, Leon Panetta, Robert Rubin, Secretary Warren Christopher, Bob Kyle, Bowman Cutter, and others. Photographs from May 25, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a satellite feed in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB) studio to the American Academy of Physician Assistants in San Antonio, Texas. Dave Anderson is present in the studio. The First Lady greets studio crew members. First

Lady Hillary Rodham visits the White House Staff mess with Capricia Marshall. The First Lady and Melanne Verveer talk with John Emerson at the Staff Mess. The First Lady greets military personnel at the West Executive Avenue entrance of the West Wing. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the International Women's Media Foundation event at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, D.C. President Clinton arrives at the Naval Academy landing zone in Annapolis, Maryland. President Clinton is met by John Dalton, Secretary of the Navy, and Rear Admiral Thomas Lynch, Superintendent of the U.S. Naval Academy at the landing zone. President Clinton arrives at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. The President is met by Admiral Jeremy (Mike) Boorda, Chief of Naval Operations, General Carl Mundy, Jr., Commandant of the Marine Corps, Rear Admiral John Padgett, III, Commandant of Midshipmen, and others. President Clinton addresses the Naval Academy Commencement Ceremony. President Clinton presents the first 100 graduates with diplomas and shake hands with remaining graduates. Graduates in the United States Navy and United States Marine Corps are commissioned, and they throw their covers (hats) in the air at the ceremony. Photographs from May 25, 1994, Continued: President Clinton talks with Israeli Prime Minister Shimon Peres in the Diplomatic Reception Room. Tony Lake and others are present at the meeting. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton walk along the White House Colonnade. The First Lady and Tipper Gore greet the Senate Spouses in the Jacqueline Kennedy Garden at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Tipper Gore host a luncheon for Senate Spouses in the State Dining Room. The First Lady and Tipper Gore address the luncheon. They greet the spouses individually in the Blue Room. The First Lady and Tipper Gore talk with Capricia Marshall. Views of the table setting and food prior to serving are included. President Clinton arrives at the U.S. Capitol with Vice President Albert Gore. President Clinton greets Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy, Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Senator John Breaux, Senator David Pryor, and Senator George Mitchell. The President and Vice President participate in a Health Care Democratic Leadership meeting with Senator George Mitchell, Representative Tom Foley, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary Donna Shalala, Representative Richard Gephardt, Representative David Bonior, Roger Altman, Representative Dan Rostenkowski, Senator David Pryor, Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy, Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, and others. In addition, President Clinton and Vice President Gore attend a meeting with Bipartisan Senators and others regarding health care. Meeting participants include Senator George Mitchell, Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Secretary Donna Shalala, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Senator

Robert Dole, Senator Robert Packwood, Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy, Senator David Durenberger, Senator Nancy Kassebaum, Senator Don Nichols, and Senator John Chafee. President Clinton addresses the House Democratic Caucus at the U.S. Capitol. Photographs from May 26, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging near the Lincoln Memorial, Reflecting Pool, and the Tidal Basin in Washington, D.C. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Representative Jack Brooks. President Clinton and Attorney General Janet Reno address the Clinic Access Bill banning blockades at abortion clinics in the Roosevelt Room. The President signs the "Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act" in the Roosevelt Room as members of Congress and Attorney General Janet Reno stand behind the President. Signing participants include Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton, Representative Anna Eshoo, Senator Barbara Boxer, Representative John Chafee, Representative Charles Schumer, Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy, Representative Jack Brooks, Representative Pat Schroeder, Representative Jolene Unsoeld, and Representative Louise Slaughter. Prior to the signing, President Clinton meets with Alexis Herman, Attorney General Janet Reno, Vice President Albert Gore, George Stephanopoulos, and Dee Dee Myers in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets the children of Dr. David Gunn, the Florida physician who was murdered by an anti-abortion protester, in the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets and talks with artist Daniel Green and family in the Diplomatic Reception Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Catholic Priests in the Map Room. President Clinton greets Peter Norton and his wife in the Oval Office. Mrs. Norton holds Socks the cat and Carolyn Huber is present. Wayne Skinner, Isabelle Tapia, and visitors take turns holding Socks the cat on the White House Colonnade. Views of Socks on Betty Currie's desk in the Outer Oval Office and lying in a wing chair. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with John Kitzhaber. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton has lunch in the Map Room with unidentified guests. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Diplomatic Reception Room with an unidentified group. A retirement reception for Don Dean, Director of the White House Photo Lab, in the Indian Treaty Room in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Participants include Don Shannon, Marilyn Jacanin, Billie Shaddix, Larry Kauffman, and the lab staff. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a tree planting ceremony on the South Lawn of the White House. Three Dogwood trees are presented to the White House by Barbara Zelenko, President of the Women's National Democratic Club, and club members. The First Lady shovels dirt around the base of one of the trees. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the Alzheimer's Research Planning

Workshop at the Madison Hotel in Washington, D.C. Participants include Zachary Fisher, Chairperson and Photographs from May 26, 1994, Continued: Founder, Fisher Medical Foundation, Melissa Katz, Chairperson of Intrepid Museum Foundation, Dr. Bijan Safai, and David Rockefeller. The First Lady addresses the workshop. President Clinton confers with staff in the Oval Office regarding most favored nation status for China. Meeting participants include Secretary Warren Christopher, Sandy Berger, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Bob Kyle, Bowman Cutter, Tony Lake, David Gergen, and Jeremy Rosner. President Clinton prepares for his press statement regarding China. President Clinton stands in the Lower Press Office of the White House with Josh King, Andrew Friendly, and others. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore talk in the Oval Office with Jeff Eller. President Clinton talks alone with George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office. Photographs from May 27, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton poses with Bob Randolph in the Oval Office. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with United Nations Secretary General Boutros Boutros-Ghali. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Ambassador Madeleine Albright, William Gray, and Tony Lake. Prior to the meeting the President meets with Sandy Berger, Strobe Talbott, Leon Fuerth, William Gray, Ambassador Albright, and Tony Lake in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets and meets with health care practitioners in the Oval Office. Irwin Redlener shows the President a flow chart of "Dr. Gleason's Office Before President Clinton's Plan." President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Laura Tyson, Alan Blinder, Robert Rubin, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos for an economics briefing. The President jokes with Leon Panetta and others prior to the meeting. President Clinton greets representatives from the Oxford Book Group in the Oval Office. President Clinton talks with Paul Waldman on the White House Colonnade. President Clinton looks down at toddler Molly McNeely on the Colonnade. Photographs from May 27, 1994, Continued: President Clinton greets television and radio crews after participating in interviews in the Cabinet Room. President Clinton participates in a radio address taping in the Roosevelt Room. Following the radio address President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office. President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Tansu Ciller of Turkey. Jim Reed and Donald Kerrick are present in the Oval Office.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
