Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 7, 1994 and June 23, 1994 through June 27, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 61) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on May 7, 1994 & June 23, 1994 through June 27, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from May 7, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with foreign policy advisors in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Lloyd Cutler, Secretary of Defense William Perry, Leon Fuerth, Ambassador Madeleine Albright, George Stephanopoulos, and General John Shalikashvili, among others. Photographs from June 23, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with California Gubernatorial candidate Kathleen Brown in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend the congressional picnic at the White House. Present include Trisha Yearwood, Capricia Marshall, and Ralph Alswang, among others. First Lady

Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests present during a HealthRight event at the United States Capitol in Washington, DC. Photographs from June 24, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with President Carlos Menem of Argentina in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Strobe Talbott, Tony Lake, and Samuel "Sandy" Berger. Also photographed is President Menem arriving at the White House and signing the guest book. President Menem is escorted by Molly Raiser. President William Jefferson Clinton greets author Peter Mathiesson at the White House. Also present are Lloyd Cutler and Harold Ickes. President William Jefferson Clinton boards Marine One en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President converses with Dee Dee Myers and Bruce Lindsey. The President departs Andrews Air Force Base en route St. Louis, Missouri. Also present are Representative Richard Gephardt, Will Itoh, and Josh King. The President arrives at Lambert St. Louis International Airport. Present are Representative Bill Clay and Mayor Freeman Bosley, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Adams Mark Hotel in St. Louis, Missouri. The President greets hotel personnel, and proceeds to a meeting with staff. Present include Dee Dee Myers, Jonathan Prince, Eli Segal, and Will Itoh, among others. Following the meeting the President proceeds to a meeting with the Post-Dispatch Editorial Board. Also photographed are Barbara Kinney and Dr. Connie Mariano. Following the meeting the President greets East St. Louis students present. Photographed include Marian Wright Edelman, Representative Jerry Costello, Sam Myers, and Bruce Lindsey, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton purchases a Metrolink ticket in route Union Station in St. Louis, Missouri. Also present are Representative Richard Gephardt, Representative Jerry Costello, Representative Bill Clay, Mayor Freeman Bosley, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and James "Jack" Leary, among others. Also photographed are students from the University of Arkansas at Union (Photographs from June 24, 1994 continued) Station with Razorback hats. The President is en route the Fox Park neighborhood. The President arrives in the Fox Park neighborhood and tours the area. Present includes Mayor Bosley, Representative Gephardt, Representative Clay, Eli Segal, Tim Hager, Leslie Jones, and Marla Martin, among others. The President participates in a Summer of Safety event. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests on the tarmac at Lambert St. Louis International Airport. The President departs St. Louis en route Andrews Air Force Base. Also photographed include Dee Dee Myers and Will Itoh. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Lisa Caputo, Mandy Grunwald, Maggie Williams, and Mike Lux at the White House. The First Lady

proceeds to a meeting with Oklahoma state opinion leaders in Room 180 of the Old Executive Office Building (EOB). Also present is Doris Matsui. Along the way she greets Set Momjian. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets representatives of Emily's List in the East Room of the White House. Following the event the First Lady participates in an interview in the Map Room. Miscellaneous photographs include Mark Middle and guests are photographed in the Oval Office and Socks the cat held by Barbara Kinney & Brian Rock. Photographs from June 25, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office of the White House. Following remarks the President greets guests present. Photographed includes Sarah McClendon, Jamie Williams, Mark Middleton, Paul Begala, Dee Dee Myers, John Emerson, Marilyn Jacanin, Ted Gnomes, Lynda Carter, Robert Altman, James Riady, Aileen Riady. A man proposes to a woman in front of the President. Following the event the President proceeds to the South Lawn landing zone and departs via Marine One en route Camp David. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Ambassador Myles Frechette and Barbara Ann Frechette at the White House. Following the meeting the First Lady also greets James Riady and Aileen Riady. Photographs from June 26, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton disembark from Marine One on the South Lawn of the White House. Photographs from June 27, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on The Mall in Washington, DC. Also photographed is Senator Barbara Boxer. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Oval Office of the White House with staff, including George Stephanopoulos, Lloyd Cutler, and Michael Cardozo. Following the meeting the President and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an academic health leaders (Photographs from June 27, 1994 are as follows) event in the East Room. Present includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Dr. Mitchell Rabkin, and Dr. William Peck. The President and First Lady greet guests in the Blue Room following the event. Photographed includes Walter Zell, Alexis Herman, Melanne Verveer, and Harold Ickes, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the American Association of University in the Indian Treaty Room of the White House. Photographed includes Doris Matsui. Following the address the First Lady proceeds to an interview with German television in the Map Room. Following the interview the First Lady greets Maurice Tempelsman. Miscellaneous photographs of White House gardeners covering plots in the Rose Garden.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
