Summary

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 62) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken June 23, 1994; June 27, 1994, through June 30, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from June 23, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton on stage with musician Trisha Yearwood at the Congressional Picnic on the South Lawn of the White House. Photographs from June 27, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton announces staff changes in the Oval Office. Changes include Alice Rivlin as the new Director of the Office of Management and Budget, Leon Panetta as White House Chief of Staff, David Gergen as Adviser on Foreign Policy to the President and Secretary of State, and Mack McLarty as a Presidential Emissary and Adviser. President Clinton meets with senior staff in the Oval Office Dining Room. Included at the meeting are Dee Dee Myers, George Stephanopoulos, Harold Ickes, Mark Gearan, Phil Lader, and others. President Clinton meets in the Roosevelt Room with Vice President Albert Gore, Sandy Berger, Tony Lake, Phil Lader, Pat Griffin, Ricki Seidman, Mark Middleton, Mark Gearan, Veronica Biggins, Alexis Herman, John Podesta, Debi Schiff, Dee Dee Myers, Robert Rubin, Gene Sperling, Carol Rasco,

George Stephanopoulos, and others. President Clinton and Mack McLarty consult with Josh King in the hallway outside the Roosevelt Room. President Clinton greets Maurice Tempelsman in the West Wing. President Clinton talks with Heather Beckel in the West Wing. George Stephanopoulos, Harold Ickes, and others are present. President Clinton joins White House Summer Interns for a group photo at the South Portico of the White House. President Clinton addresses a conference on Africa in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Vice President Albert Gore and Alexis Herman share the dais with the President. The President greets guests including Andrew Young in the audience. President Clinton meets with Lloyd Cutler, Michael Cardozo, and George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office. The Clintons confer with Walter Zell, Alexis Herman, and Melanne Verveer in the Blue Room of the White House. President Clinton talks with Harold Ickes and Andrew Friendly in the Blue Room. Photographs from June 27, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the Yale Law School dinner at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. President Clinton greets staff and South Lawn visitors prior to departing the White House on Marine One for a trip to New York. The President arrives at Andrews Air Force Base and departs for New York. During the flight, the President meets with Senator Bill Bradley and Harold Ickes. In addition, while aboard Air Force One, President Clinton confers with Bruce Lindsey, Harold Ickes, and Jeff Eller. President Clinton arrives at John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) in New York. The President is accompanied at arrival with Senator Bill Bradley. President Clinton boards Marine One for his flight to the Wall Street landing zone in New York. President Clinton addresses the Democratic National Committee (DNC) dinner at the St. Regis Hotel in New York and a DNC Gala reception at the Sheraton New York Hotel. President Clinton applauds Governor Mario Cuomo during the Governor's speech at the reception. DNC Chairman David Wilhelm is present at both events. President Clinton meets with children sponsored by the Make-A-Wish Foundation at the St. Regis Hotel in New York. The President greets their families and others at the meeting. President Clinton departs JFK Airport in New York to travel back to Andrews Air Force Base. During the flight, President Clinton meets with Senator Bill Bradley, Senator Frank Lautenberg, David Wilhelm, and others. Photographs from June 28, 1994, are as follows: Mack McLarty greets staff and interns in the West Wing. President Eduardo Frei of Chile arrives at the White House by motorcade on the North Grounds. President Frei is met in the West Wing by Molly Raiser, Department of State Chief of Protocol. President Frei signs the guest book in the Roosevelt Room. President Clinton and President Frei meet in the Oval Office. The Presidents walk along the White House Colonnade

to the Old Family Dining Room where they have lunch. Lunch participants include Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Mickey Kantor, Robert Rubin, and others. Following the lunch, President Clinton talks alone with Secretary Warren Christopher. President Clinton meets in the Photographs from June 28, 1994, Continued: library with Secretary Christopher, Mark Gearan, Tony Lake, Leon Fuerth, and Sandy Berger. President Clinton walks along the Colonnade to the West Wing with Mark Gearan. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office regarding healthcare with First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Tipper Gore, Melanne Verveer, Pat Griffin, George Stephanopoulos, Maggie Williams, Mack McLarty, Harold Ickes, and Ira Magaziner. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the Economic Club of Washington at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington. Tony Lake greets departing National Security Council staff in the West Wing. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Ira Magaziner meet in the Diplomatic Reception Room with Rhode Island Opinion Leaders regarding healthcare. President Clinton greets Michael Gaines, Jr., Michael Tucker, Kay Gaines, and Peggy Tucker in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets Melinda Bates and Joyce Bonnett on the Colonnade. President Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room regarding his trip to Europe in July with Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Leon Panetta, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Joan Spero, Laura Tyson, Secretary Robert Reich, Tony Lake, Bowman Cutter, Robert Rubin, Ricki Seidman, Mark Gearan, and others. President Clinton talks alone with Secretary Bentsen in the Cabinet Room. Secretary Christopher talks alone with Robert Rubin in the Cabinet Room. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore address the African American Constituents Day reception in the East Room. President Clinton greets guests individually in the Blue Room. President Clinton talks with Alexis Herman and others in the Green Room following the reception. President Clinton arrives at the Sheraton Carlton Hotel in Washington to attend a fundraiser for Senator Jim Sasser and Senator Paul Sarbanes. President Clinton greets hotel personnel. President Clinton walks along the Colonnade with Vice President Albert Gore and Alexis Herman. Photographs from June 28, 1994, Continued: President Clinton talks alone with Mack McLarty in the doorway of the South Portico entrance to the White House. Photographs from June 29, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Diplomatic Reception Room with Oregon Opinion Leaders regarding healthcare. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Lynn Scherr in the West Wing. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Ann Bartley and her family in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). President Clinton greets Steve Humphries, Linda Humphries, Rocky Wellmuth, and Diane Wellmuth in the Oval Office. Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
