Summary

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 66) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken July 8, 1994, through July 9, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from July 8, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton participates in a bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama of Japan at the Hotel Vesuvio in Naples, Italy. President Clinton has a debriefing with Secretary Warren Christopher, Mickey Kantor, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Laura Tyson, Robert Rubin, Bowman Cutter, David Gergen, Don Baer, and others at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton joins Prime Minister Murayama for a press statement at the hotel. President Clinton goes jogging with U.S. Army personnel in Naples. President Clinton greets personnel at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton meets with Italian Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi at the Hotel Vesuvio. Meeting participants include Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Tony Lake, Mack McLarty, Ambassador Reginald Bartholomew, and Sandy Vershbow. Molly Raiser and William Itoh have dinner at a restaurant in Naples. President Clinton meets with Prime Minister John Major of Great Britain, Secretary Warren Christopher, Douglas Hurd,

and Tony Lake at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton talks alone with Bob Fauver after the meeting. President Clinton participates in a bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Jean Chretien of Canada at the Hotel Vesuvio. Meeting participants include Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Mack McLarty, Mickey Kantor, Laura Tyson, Robert Rubin, and Sandy Vershbow. President Clinton visits a church and a pizza restaurant during a walking tour of Naples. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Beryl Ann Bentsen, and Chelsea Clinton arrive at the Villa Rufolo in Ravello, Italy. They are met by the Mayor of Ravello, and they attend a performance of the Schleswig-Holstein Philharmonic. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Chelsea Clinton arrive at Villa Ciambrone in Ravello, Italy. The First Lady greets Villa staff. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Chelsea Clinton visit Santa Chiara Church. They tour the church with Padre Diomed Foliero and student tour guides. President Clinton greets Hotel Vesuvio personnel. Photographs from July 8, 1994, Continued: President Clinton participates in a G-7 working dinner at the Castel Dell'Ovo (Egg Castle) with Economic Summit leaders: Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi, Italy; President Francois Mitterrand, France; Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Germany; Prime Minister John Major, Great Britain; Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama, Japan; and President Jacques Delors, European Union. The leaders look at the view from the Castle wall. President Clinton meets with Bob Fauver and Bowman Cutter at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton tapes his weekly radio address at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton works with Michael Waldman, Don Baer, Mack McLarty, Laura Tyson, George Stephanopoulos, and David Gergen during the taping session. Photographs from July 9, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging in Naples. The President greets police and Hotel Vesuvio personnel. President Clinton participates in meetings with G-7 Economic Summit leaders at the Palazzo Reale in Naples. President Clinton meets with Foreign Finance Ministers in the Sala Della Guardie. President Clinton participates in a class photo with G-7 leaders on the terrace at the Palazzo Reale. President Clinton participates in an economic growth and jobs creation meeting in the Sala Diplomatica. President Clinton meets with leaders regarding Ukraine. President Clinton participates in a plenary session with leaders and ministers. The session oversees the release of the Communique (Summit Declaration). The leaders present include European Union President Jacques Delors, Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama, Japan, Prime Minister Jean Chretien, Canada, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Germany, Prime Minister John Major, Great Britain, Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi, Italy, and President Francois Mitterrand, France. President Clinton confers with cabinet and staff throughout the

day including Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Mickey Kantor, Laura Tyson, Mack McLarty, Tony Lake, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Bowman Cutter, Bob Fauver, Robert Rubin, Michael Waldman, Mike McCurry, and others. President Clinton meets at the Palazzo Reale with advisers regarding his press statement. Meeting participants include Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Dee Dee Myers, Laura Tyson, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, Bowman Cutter, Secretary Warren Christopher, Mack McLarty, Mickey Kantor, Bob Fauver, Mark Gearan, and others. Photographs from July 9, 1994, Continued: President Clinton meets with Prince Bandar of Saudi Arabia at the Hotel Vesuvio. President Clinton talks to reporters on the sidewalk in Naples. President Clinton greets people at the Hotel Vesuvio. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the Naples Opera House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Veronica Berlusconi, and the spouses of the G-7 Economic Summit leaders have lunch at Bartolini's Hall Restaurant in Naples. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Veronica Berlusconi, and the spouses of the G-7 Economic Summit leaders tour and have a reception at the Villa Pignatelli in Naples. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Veronica Berlusconi, and spouses of the G-7 Economic leaders tour the San Martino Church in Naples. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Veronica Berlusconi, and spouses of the G-7 Economic leaders visit St. Elmo Castle. The group tours the museum, and they stand outside the Castle in Naples.

Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
