Approximately 2,660 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from July 9, 1994 through July 11, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is a trip to the G-7 Summit in Naples, Italy.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 67) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on July 9, 1994 through July 11, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is a trip to the G-7 Summit in Naples, Italy. Photographs from July 9, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a G-7 economic summit dinner at the Palazzo Caserta in Naples, Italy. Present includes President Oscar Luigi Scalfaro, Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi, Veronica Berlusconi, President Francois Mitterrand, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama (村山 富市), Prime Minister Jean Chretien, Aline Chretien, Prime Minister John Major, European Union President Jacques Delors, Marie Delors, and President Boris Yeltsin, among others. Following the dinner the participants gather for a group photograph. Also photographed are fireworks outside the venue. First Lady Hillary Rodham

Clinton meets with Veronica Berlusconi in Naples, Italy. The First Lady tours St. Elmo castle and museum. Later the First Lady tours the Villa Pignatelli and participates in a reception. Chelsea Clinton and Capricia Marshall are photographed on Capri Island in Naples, Italy. Photographs from July 10, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting and large photograph opportunity during the G-7 economic summit at the Palazzo Reale in Naples, Italy. Present includes President Boris Yeltsin, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, European Union President Jacques Delors, Prime Minister Jean Chretien, Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama (村山 富夫), President Francois Mitterrand, and Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi. Also photographed includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, Nick Burns, David Gergen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Michael Waldman, and Carter Wilkie. Later President Clinton meets with President Yeltsin in a bi-lateral meeting and are photographed walking along the terrace prior to delivering a press statement in the theatre. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton tour the ruins of Pompeii in Italy. Also photographed are Dorothy Rodham and Capricia Marshall. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tours the San Lorenzo archeological museum in Naples, Italy. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton greet staff at Hotel Vesuvio in Naples, Italy. The President individually greets police officers. Following the event the President and First Lady proceed to Naples Airport and participate in an event for Embassy personnel prior to departing for Bonn, Germany. Photographs from July 11, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Berlin Airport in Germany. The President and First Lady greet Jock Covey and Mayor Eberhard Diepgen. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an arrival ceremony at the Villa Hammerschmidt. Present includes President Roman Herzog & Christiane Herzog. President Clinton and President Herzog greet the United States delegation and German officials, including Chancellor Helmut Kohl. President Clinton, President Herzog, and Chancellor Helmut Kohl proceed to walk along the grounds. (Photographs from July 11, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton disembark Marine One at Worms landing Zone in Bonn, Germany. The President and First Lady greet United States personnel present. Photographed includes Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Secretary of State Warren Christopher and Ambassador Richard Holbrooke. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests at the Petersburg guest house in Bonn, Germany. Chancellor Helmut Kohl hosts a

luncheon for the Clintons. Later the President meets with party leader. Present include Rudolf Schauping, Hans Ulrich Kose, and Klaus Kinkel. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Ramstein Air Force Base in Germany. The President & First Lady disembark Marine One.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
