## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created from July 10, 1994 through July 15, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 69) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on July 10, 1994 through July 15, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from July 10, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton depart Naples, Italy en route Bonn, Germany. Also photographed is the First Lady touring a museum in Naples, Italy. Photographs from July 11, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an arrival ceremony at the Villa Hammerschmidt in Bonn, Germany. Also photographed is the First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Museum of Contemporary History Photographs from July 12, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Reichstag in Berlin, Germany. The President greets Bundestag President Rita Suessmuth, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and President Jacques Delors. President Clinton, President Delors, and Chancellor Kohl participate in a trilateral meeting and

expanded plenary session. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton walk from the Reichstag to the Brandenburg Gate. Accompanying the President and First Lady are Chancellor Helmut Kohl and Hannelore Kohl. Mayor Eberhard Diepgen & Monika Diepgen are greeted at the gate. Also photographed are Chelsea Clinton, Ambassador Richard Holbrook, and Mort Engelberg. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit the Neue Synagogue in Berlin, Germany. Present include Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Hannelore Kohl, Kanstain Muenz, and Hermann Simon, among others. President Clinton and Chancellor Kohl are presented with gifts. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit the Rathaus city hall in Berlin, Germany. Accompanying the President and First Lady are Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Hannelore Kohl, Mayor Eberhard Diepgen, and Hanna Renate Laurien. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at McNair barracks in Berlin, Germany. Present is Chancellor Helmut Kohl, General Walter Yates, General David Maddox, and Colonel Jimmy Banks, among others. The President tours the facility and addresses the troops at the inactivation ceremony of the Berlin brigade. President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and Hannelore Kohl tour the Pergamum Museum and National Cathedral in Berlin, Germany. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with advisers regarding his speech at the Brandenburg Gate in Germany. Present includes Ambassador Richard Holbrook, Don Baer, David Gergen, Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, and Bob Boorstin, among others. The President, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, Hannelore Kohl, and Mort Engelberg meet prior to the speaking event. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet embassy personnel at North Field Berlin Tegel International Airport. Also present include Ambassador Richard Holbrook, Secretary of State Warren Christopher. The President, First Lady, and United States delegation depart en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed includes Dee Dee Myers, Wendy Smith, George Stephanopoulos, Mike Lufrano, Kelly Craighead, Ricki Seidman, Bob Boorstin, Melanne Verveer, Nancy Hernreich, Will Itoh, and Brad Smith, among others. Chelsea Clinton is photographed in Berlin, Germany. Also present are Capricia Marshall and Molly Raiser. Photographs from July 13, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs in Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Southwest Georgia Regional Airport to tour flood damage. Present is Governor Zell Miller. The President tours the flood damage via Maine One. Following the tour the President meets with Federal Emergency

Management Agency (FEMA) officials at the Ayres Corporation. Present includes James Lee Witt, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Governor Lawton Chiles, and Leon Panetta, among others. The President tours the aid distribution site. Also photographed are staff at an emergency telephone bank including Jeff Eller, Christine Varney, Bruce Lindsey, and Richard Strauss. The President departs from Southwest Georgia Regional Airport en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President arrives at Andrews Air Force Base and disembarks Air Force One. Socks the Cat is photographed on the South Lawn of the White House. Photographs from July 14, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Leon Panetta, Carol Rasco, Robert Rubin, and Pat Griffin in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Harold Ickes, Steve Ricchetti, Ira Magaziner, Pat Griffin, George Stephanopoulos, Pat Griffin, and Rahm Emanuel regarding health care. Later the President meets with Senator J. Bennett Johnston, Senator Kent Conrad, Senator Byron Dorgan, and Senator Joseph Lieberman in separate meetings. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Senator Tom Harkin, Leon Panetta, and Pat Griffin in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Also Present are Chris Jennings, Melanne Verveer, Skila Harris, and Ira Magaziner. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a health care meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes George Stephanopoulos, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Leon Panetta, Melanne Verveer, Ira Magaziner, Harold Ickes, Skila Harris, Chris Jennings, and Maggie Williams. President William Jefferson Clinton & Frank Posey are photographed in the West Wing of the White House looking at a poster from the Brandenburg Gate event. The President chooses where the poster is hung. Photographs from July 15, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Oval Office of the White House prior to a press briefing. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Dennis Ross, Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Mark Gearan, Martin Indyk, Mike McCurry, and Dee Dee Myers. Following the meeting the President and Secretary Christopher proceed to the press conference in the Press Briefing Room of the White House regarding the upcoming visit of Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel and King Hussein bin Talal of Jordan to the White House. Also photographed at the event is Tony Lake. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with President Hafiz Asad of Syria on the telephone in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Tony Lake, Martin Indyk, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Jim Reed. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with guests at the White House prior

to departing for Greensburg, Pennsylvania. The President departs the White House via Marine One and arrives at Air Force One. Photographed includes Bruce Lindsey, Dee Dee Myers, Ira Magaziner, Paul Begala, John Hart, and Representative Austin Murphy. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Ambassador Ojars Eriks Kalnins of Latvia in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. The First Lady is presented with a loaf of bread and a quilt. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Donna Conrad in the Map Room of the White House.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
