Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from July 15, 1994 through July 19, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 70) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on July 15, 1994 through July 19, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from July 15, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos. Later, the President speaks on the telephone with President Hafiz Asad of Syria. Photographed includes Jim Reed, Tony Lake, Martin Indyk, and Samuel "Sandy" Berger. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House prior to departure for Greensburg, Pennsylvania. The President departs the White House via Marine One and transfers to Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed includes Jamie Williams, Bruce Lindsey, Ira Magaziner, Paul Begala, John Hart, Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, and Representative Austin Murphy. The President arrives in Pennsylvania. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Westmoreland

County Airport (Arnold Palmer Airport) in Latrobe, Pennsylvania. The President greets guests & volunteers present, and prepares to depart via the Presidential motorcade en route Greensburg, Pennsylvania. Also photographed is Representative Austin Murphy and Bruce Lindsey. The President arrives in Greensburg and delivers a health care speech to a crowd on Main Street. Present includes Major Kevin Fajt, Representative Murphy, Senator Harris Wofford, Louis Mastowski, and Lynn Hicks, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton tapes his weekly radio address at the Public Ledger Building in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The President greets guests following the recording. Later the President meets with the Philadelphia Inquirer editorial board. Following the meeting the President proceeds to a dinner. The President speaks with Senator Joseph Biden and Senator Harris Wofford. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests present on the tarmac at Philadelphia International Airport prior to departure via Air Force One from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Also photographed includes Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers and Bruce Lindsey. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests in the Map Room of the White House. The First Lady proceeds to a staff meeting with Melanne Vermeer, Ann Stock, and Patti Solis. Also photographed is President William Jefferson Clinton who stops by. Photographs from July 16, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at the White House prior to departing for the Robert Trent Jones golf club. The President greets guests outside the golf club. Photographed includes Beryl Anthony, Turman Arnold, Robert Armstrong, and Webb Hubbell. Photographs from July 17, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Senator Dennis DeConcini and Senator Howell Heflin in separate meetings in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton attends a reception at the Grand Hyatt Hotel in Washington, DC. Present includes Senator Robert Byrd and Bryan Wilson, among others. (Photographs from July 17, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Miami International Airport in Miami, Florida. Photographed includes Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Alexis Herman, Reta Jo Lewis, Suzanna Valdez, and Representative Esteban Torres. Photographs from July 18, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the host committee for the Summit of the Americas at the Sheraton Bal Harbour Hotel in Miami, Florida. Present includes Governor Lawton Chiles. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the National Council of La Raza's luncheon at the Miami Beach Convention Center in Miami, Florida. Present includes Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Raul Yzaguirre (President; National Council of La Raza), and Representative

Ed Pastor, among others. Prior to the event the President confers with Alexis Herman, Suzanna Valdez, Bruce Lindsey, and Secretary Cisneros. President William Jefferson Clinton departs Miami International Airport in Miami, Florida en route Brunswick Naval Air Station in Portland, Maine. The President speaks with the press prior to departure. Also photographed is Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers. The President arrives at Brunswick Naval Air Station. The President boards Marine One en route Portland, Maine. Photographed includes Susan Brophy and Kirk Hanlin. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a reception in the Eastland Ballroom at the Sonesta Hotel in Portland, Maine. Present includes Senator George Mitchell, Representative Tom Andrews, Governor Joseph Brennan, David Wilhelm, and Victoria Murphy. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the Brunswick Naval Air Station in Portland, Maine, en route Boston, Massachusetts. The President arrives in Boston Logan International Airport in Boston. President William Jefferson Clinton has a meeting at the Holiday Inn by the Bay in Boston, Massachusetts. Present includes Representative Thomas H. Andrews and David Wilhelm, among others. Staff meet in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Present includes Leon Panetta, Secretary of ___ Mike Espy, Representative Tom Foley, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Laura Tyson, Pat Griffin, Mickey Kantor, and Robert Rubin. Photographs from July 19, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton goes jogging in Boston, Massachusetts. Present includes Governor Evan Bayh and Fred Siegel. The President greets police officers during the jog. President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a health care speech to the National Governors Association meeting at the Hynes Convention Center in Boston, Massachusetts. Prior to delivering remarks at the event the President works on his speech. Photographed includes Mark Gearan, Marcia Hale, John Hart, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Kathi Way, Bruce Lindsey, Nancy Soderberg, and Keith Mason (Photographs from July 19, 1994 continued:) President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Bryant family at Ann's Cafeteria In Boston, Massachusetts. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at Boston Logan International Airport. The President departs Boston en route Andrews Air Force Base. Also photographed includes Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, Mark Gearan, Wendy Smith, Andrew Friendly, Josh King, and Reta Jo Lewis. President William Jefferson Clinton disembarks Marine One on the South Lawn of the White House. The President greets guests present at the White House. The President confers with staff in the Diplomatic Reception Room including Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, Harold Ickes, and Leon Panetta. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview with Joan Lunden and Charlie Gibson on "Good Morning

America” in New York, New York. The First Lady greets television crew and staff present for the broadcast of the interview. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the American Society of Magazine Editors’ luncheon at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel in New York, New York. Later the First Lady attends a reception at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel. Present among guests is Representative Charles Rangel and Jean MacArthur (wife of General Douglas MacArthur). First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests prior to departing New York, New York en route Andrews Air Force Base. Erskine Bowles and Robert Rubin meet with Small Business leaders in the Old Executive Office Building in Washington, DC.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
