Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from March 13, 1994, March 18, 1994, through March 22, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 25) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken March 13, 1994 & March 18, 1994, through March 22, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from March 13, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton greets people on the South Lawn prior to departing the White House for a trip to Detroit, Michigan. Photographs from March 18, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a taping of a "Harry & Louise" comedic health care message for the Gridiron Dinner. The Clintons are videotaped in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB) Studio. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton discusses health care in the Indian Treaty Room with regional press from Kansas, Oklahoma, and Nebraska. Secretary Donna Shalala is present at the press event. President Clinton participates in a round table discussion on health care in the Oval Office with wire service reporters and photographers. President Clinton holds up a health care issues sign during the round table event. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary

Rodham Clinton host a dinner party in the residence. Guests include Paul Newman, Joanne Woodward, Liz Robbins, Representative Steny Hoyer, and others. Paul Newman makes popcorn in the residence kitchen for the President. Views of table settings and a dessert plating of a chocolate creation of a film reel in the State Dining Room. Paul Newman and Joanne Woodward greet Nancy Hennreich, Betty Currie, Kelly Craighead, and Heather Beckel in the Outer Oval Office. Photographs from March 19, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office following his weekly radio address. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the West Garden Room with Lisa Caputo, Maggie Williams, Ann Stock, Capricia Marshall, and Melanne Verveer prior to departing for Arlington, Virginia. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Gannett Headquarters for the Gridiron Gannett luncheon. The First Lady greets Katherine Graham, Carly Simon, Ken Burns, and others. The First Lady addresses the luncheon. Photographs from March 19, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a videotaping at the Harriman Studio at the Democratic National Committee's headquarters in Washington, D.C. The First Lady records a video entitled "Women in Congress - Making A Difference." The First Lady also participates in a teleconference with various universities and medical organizations from across the country. President Clinton drops by the East Room to view the set up for the ABC Kids Town Hall Meeting. President Clinton greets Peter Jennings and Roone Arledge in the Cross Hall of the White House. President Clinton talks with Bob Boorstin and Mark Gearan before joining the ABC Kids Town Hall Meeting in the East Room. President Clinton takes questions from children as Peter Jennings moderates the town hall meeting. President Clinton greets children and their families in the Blue Room following the town hall meeting. President Clinton golfs with Mack Geschwind at the Army-Navy Country Club in Virginia. Photographs from March 20, 1994, are as follows: Carolyn Huber, and a group pose for photos in the Oval Office. Kelly Crawford, and a group of her friends pose for photos in the Oval Office. Bob Currie and staff from the Environmental Protection Agency pose for photos in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets people in the Diplomatic Reception Room prior to departing the South Lawn for Miami, Florida. President Clinton greets Rob Reiner on the South Grounds. President Clinton First Lady Hillary Rodham depart the White House for Andrews Air Force Base. The Clintons disembark Marine One and depart on Air Force One for Miami. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Miami International Airport. President Clinton greets State Senator Daryl Jones and his family after arriving. President Clinton talks to reporters in the press pool at the

airport. The Clintons board Marine One and travel to Fisher Island, Florida. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive on Fisher Island via Marine One. The Clintons drive a golf cart on Fisher Island. Photographs from March 21, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes golfing with Hugh Rodham, Raymond "Ray" Floyd, and others on Fisher Island. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton ride in a golf cart to the Marine One Landing Zone and depart for Century Village East for a Health Care Forum in Hillsborough, Florida. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Century Village East for a Health Care Forum and greet former Governor Michael Dukakis, Kitty Dukakis, Governor Lawton Chiles, Lieutenant Governor Buddy MacKay, and others. The President and First Lady address the Health Care Forum. The Clintons greet health care letter writers. The Clintons participate in a question-and-answer session at the forum. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive on Fisher Island after attending a Health Care Forum at Century Village East in Hillsborough, Florida. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton drive in a golf cart before departing Fisher Island for Miami. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meet with children from the Florida Children's Wish Foundation at the Sheraton Bal Harbour in Miami. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Chuck Mangione, the entertainer for the Democratic National Committee (DNC) Fundraising dinner at the Sheraton Bal Harbour in Miami. President Clinton confers with David Wilhelm and Jeff Eller prior to attending the dinner. The Clintons address the DNC dinner. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet people at Miami International Airport. The Clintons depart Miami for Andrews Air Force Base. President Clinton greets guests aboard the flight on Air Force One. Photographs from March 22, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with Chancellor Helmut Kohl of Germany. Jim Reed assists the President on the call. Tony Lake and George Stephanopoulos are present in the Oval Office. Photographs from March 22, 1994, Continued: President Clinton greets Maurice Smith, Jim Pladger, and others in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets Bonnie Dean in the Oval Office. President Clinton visits with Bonnie Dean and Robert Rubin in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton greets Rabbi Levy in the Oval Office. President Clinton talks with Leon Panetta on West Executive Avenue outside the West Wing. President Clinton participates in a Small Business Heroes Health Care event in the Old Executive Office Building (EOB). Erskine Bowles and Representative John LaFalce participate in the event. President Clinton greets Chad Griffin and his Grandparents in the West

Wing. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Susan Lang and her family in the Diplomatic Reception Room. In addition, the First Lady greets Pen Rodine and Eleana Kubler in the Diplomatic Reception Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Royal Netherlands residence in Washington, D.C. to attend a Celebration of Tulips. Ambassador Adriaan Jacobovits De Szeged greets the First Lady. The First Lady meets Arnold Parzer, Agricultural Counselor, Hildebrandt Van Eeden, President of the American Dutch Bulb Export Association, and Marcel Wolterinck, Flower Decorator. Frans Hulsman, Press and Cultural Counselor of the Embassy, announces the tulip christening of the "Hillary Clinton" tulips.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
