Summary

This collection consists of records related to a wide variety of domestic policy topics Ron Klain was involved with while serving as Chief of Staff to Vice President Al Gore from 1995-1999. Major subjects covered in these emails include the environment, 1996 Atlanta Summer Olympics, Enterprise Communities, Empowerment Zones, crime and policing, the Internet, and anti-tobacco initiatives.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0556-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Materials responsive to this FOIA request include all emails created by Ron Klain. The responsive records cover a wide variety of domestic policy topics Klain was involved with while serving as Chief of Staff to Vice President Al Gore. Major subjects covered in these emails include the environment, 1996 Atlanta Summer Olympics, Enterprise Communities, Empowerment Zones, crime and policing, the Internet, and anti-tobacco initiatives. Ron Klain worked on the Clinton-Gore 1992 campaign and was later an Associate Counsel to the President focusing on judicial nominations. He was named Chief of Staff to Attorney General Janet Reno in 1994, and in 1995 Klain became Chief of Staff to Vice President Al Gore, serving from 1995-1999. He joined the law firm of O'Melveny & Myers from 1999-2005, and later served as Chief of Staff to Vice President Joe Biden from 2009-2011. In January 2021, Klain began serving as White House Chief of Staff, a position he held until February 2023.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]; and Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Tape Restoration Project [Email]. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. Search strings are used to locate electronic records responsive to FOIA requests, and responsive assets are placed into Search Results Lists (SRLs). Depending on the complexity of the search, there may be multiple SRLs within each SAS. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The Tape Restoration Project (TRP) is a database consisting of restored emails from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) from July 1994 through June of 2000. The TRP is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
