Summary

This collection consists of records related to Oklahoma Senator David Boren from January 20, 1993 to July 1, 1994. The bulk of the records are news articles, wire reports, and press material regarding Boren and the Senate Finance Committee, proposed 1993 British Thermal Unit (BTU) energy tax, health care reform, and Safe Drinking Water Act reauthorization.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2020-0915-F (Segment 1) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Materials responsive to this FOIA request include emails mentioning David Boren. The bulk of the records are news articles, wire reports, and press material regarding Boren and the Senate Finance Committee, proposed 1993 British Thermal Unit (BTU) energy tax, health care reform, and Safe Drinking Water Act reauthorization. David Boren served as United States Senator from Oklahoma from 1979-1994. Prior to being elected to the U.S. Senate, he was Governor of Oklahoma from 1975-1979 and served in the Oklahoma House of Representatives from 1967-1974. He resigned from the U.S. Senate in 1994 to become President of the University of Oklahoma, a position he held until June 2018.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. Search strings are used to locate electronic records responsive to FOIA requests, and responsive assets are placed into Search Results Lists (SRLs). Depending on the complexity of the search, there may be multiple SRLs within each SAS. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
