Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from January 31, 1994, through February 3, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is an official visit by German Chancellor Helmut Kohl and various high level staff and cabinet meetings on health care.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 9) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from January 31, 1994 through February 3, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is an official visit by German Chancellor Helmut Kohl and various high-level staff and cabinet meetings on health care. Records responsive to this case were processed in FOIA case number 2018-0726-F as well. Photographs from January 31, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with German Chancellor Helmut Kohl at The Filomena Ristorante of Georgetown in Washington, DC. Following the meeting President Clinton and Chancellor Kohl return to the White House. Chancellor Kohl greets First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton in the Diplomatic Reception Room. Chancellor Kohl departs the White House via limousine at the South Portico. President William

Jefferson Clinton greets Max Parker, former press secretary during the 1992 Presidential campaign. Later the President greets John Gaughan and Rudy Lowe in the Oval Office. The President speaks alone with David Watkins. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Les Aspin, Tony Lake, Strobe Talbot, Nicholas Burns, David Gergen, and Samuel "Sandy" Berger. President William Jefferson Clinton reviews speech notes. The President departs for the Omni Shoreham Hotel to address the Democratic Governors Association dinner. Photographed include Wendy Smith, Governor Evan Bayh, Susan Bayh, and Ray Ranev, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with spouses of United States' Governors at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with representatives from the National Wildlife Research Center. Present at the meeting includes Jane Sullivan and Lynda Johnson Robb, among other. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Pixie Hankinson and Perry Hankinson. Later Mrs. Clinton greets the Kuhen family. Socks the cat visits veterans and medical personnel at the old soldiers and airmen home. Photographs from February 1, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Oval Office. Present include David Gergen, Bob Boorstin, Mack McLarty, Mark Gearan, Gene Sperling, Ira Magaziner, Carol Rasco, and Dee Dee Myers. Later the President meets with Governor Mike Sullivan. Following this meeting, the President converses with Joseph Califano, Lee Brown, and Carol Rasco, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr. pose for a group photograph with Prime Minister Valdis Birkavs of Latvia and the Latvian delegation in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton announces Deval Patrick as the Nominee for the Justice Department Civil Rights Division. Present includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Deval Patrick, Attorney General Janet Reno, George Stephanopoulos, and Howard Paster, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Representative Charles Schumer in the Oval Office of the White House. (February 1, 1994 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a health care meeting with corporate executive officers in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Also present includes Roger Altman, Bob Rubin, Alexis Herman, Harold Ickes, and Ira Magaziner, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks to the press pool prior to the National Governors' Association Conference at the J. W. Marriott in Washington, DC. The President is briefed prior to his remarks. Present at the event includes Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala, Christine Heenan, Kathi Way, Carol

Rasco, and Bob Boorstin. The President addresses the conference. Present on the dais include Governor John Engler, Governor Howard Dean, and Governor Carroll Campbell. President William Jefferson Clinton departs the White House. The President arrives at the Washington Hilton Hotel in Washington, DC for an event for the American Hospital Association. Present included Dick Davidson (President, AHA), Janet Davidson, Carolyn Roberts, Edward Connors. Prior to his remarks the President speaks with Bob Boorstin and Jason Soloman. Following his remarks, the President greets guests backstage and speaks to the press pool. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a sub-cabinet meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present at the meeting includes Lee Brown, Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Ira Magaziner, Harold Ickes, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Roger Altman, Jesse Brown, and Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, among others. The First Lady converses with Mack McLarty, Mandy Grunwald, and George Stephanopoulos. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Yoly Reddam at the White House. Photographs from February 2, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton jogs with the Olympic torch bearers. Also present is Representative Tom McMillen. Upon return to the White House the President converses with Betty Currie and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Les Aspin, Tony Lake, Strobe Talbott, Nicholas Burns, David Gergen. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a congressional crime meeting in the Cabinet Room at the White House. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, Tim Keating, Senators George Mitchell, Robert Dole, Alan Simpson, Thad Cochran, and Bob Michel, Representatives Newt Gingrich, David Bonior, and Steny Hoyer, among others. Following the meeting the President proceeds to the Oval Office. The President meets with Janet Reno, Rahm Emanuel, Carol Rasco, Pat Griffin, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Ron Klain, and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the congressional bipartisan leadership at the White House. Present at the meeting includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Representative Tom Foley, Senator Wendell Ford, Representative David Bonior, Representative Steny Hoyer, Senator George Mitchell, Representative Robert Michel, Senator David Pryor, Representative New Gingrich, Senator Robert Dole, Representative Richard Gephardt, Senator Alan Simpson, Senator Thad Cochran, Mack McLarty, Leon Panetta, Mark Gearan, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Phil Lader, and Steve Ricchetti, among others. At another point following the

meeting, the President converses with Representative Foley. President William Jefferson Clinton attends the Department of Labor conference on re-employment. The backdrop behind the dais reads "Getting America Back to Work." The President greets staff prior to the event, and guests in attendance following the conference. Also present include Robert Reich, Jonathan Prince, Gene Sperling, and David Kusnet. President William Jefferson Clinton shops at Mystery Books in Dupont Circle, Washington, DC. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Manuel Barnes and Maurie Barnes in the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview with Elizabeth Drew. Present with the First Lady is Lisa Caputo. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Jordan Kokich and her father Christopher Daniel Kokich in the Vermeil Room of the White House. Socks the cat is present. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Frank D. Roosevelt, III in the Red Room of the White House. The First Lady is presented with a bronze sculpture of Eleanor Roosevelt. Present include sculptor Penelope Jencks, Anne Helen Hess, Martha Land, and Herbert Zohn. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton receives the Distinguished Service Award from Dr. Merle Roy Schwarz, Chairman of the National Center for Health Education. Also present are David Andrews and Michelle Reich. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets artist David Schuman in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. Mr. Schuman presents the First Lady with a portrait of the President and the First Lady. Photographs from February 3, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore attend the annual National Prayer Breakfast at the Washington Hilton hotel in Washington, DC. Present include Dr. Philip Woganam, Susan Baker, Dr. Richard Halverson, Stephen Hayes, Senators Howell Heflin, Patrick Leahy, Howard Mezenbaum & Mark Hatfield, and Representative Tony Hall, among others. President Clinton is photographed prior to the event on a telephone. The President converses with Dee Dee Myers. Also present is Wendy Smith and Linda Lader. The First Lady converses with Andrew Young. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses students at Kramer Junior High School in Washington, DC. The President greets David Neff and Philip Yancey of Christianity Today outside the school. The President participates in an interview in the Presidential limousine en route the White House.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
