## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created from February 6, 1994, through February 8, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 11) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from February 6, 1994, through February 8, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from February 6, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton bowls at the White House Bowling Alley with Danny Wexler and the Driver family including Michael Driver, Sr., Michael Driver, Jr., and Lindsey Driver. President Clinton meets in the White House Library with Secretary Warren Christopher, Madeleine Albright, Secretary William Perry, National Security Advisor Tony Lake, Mack McLarty, Leon Fuerth, Sandy Berger, David Gergen, Dee Dee Myers, and George Stephanopoulos. President Clinton reviews his schedule in the hallway of the Ground Floor Residence with Mack McLarty, Nancy Hernreich and Bruce Lindsey. Secretary Warren Christopher talking with George Stephanopoulos and Madeleine Albright in the hallway of the Ground Floor Residence. President Clinton greets Harold Ickes and his family in the hallway of the Ground Floor Residence. President Clinton talks to press on the South Lawn prior to departing for

Houston, Texas. President Clinton greets people on the South Lawn prior to departing for Houston. President Clinton crosses the South Lawn with Dee Dee Myers and Jane Gottemoeller and departs on Marine One to Andrews Air Force Base. President Clinton plays cards aboard Marine One with Bruce Lindsey. President Clinton greets guests on Air Force One in the Conference Room during the flight to Houston. President Clinton talks alone with Representative Craig Washington during the flight. John Dalton greets staff on the flight. President Clinton arrives at Ellington Field in Houston. President Clinton disembarks Air Force One with Secretary Lloyd Bentsen. President Clinton and Secretary Bentsen greets people on the tarmac in Houston. President Clinton meets with the Democratic Party Steering Committee at the Wortham Center in Houston. President Clinton participates in a dinner and reception with the committee. Participants include Governor Ann Richards, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, David Wilhelm, and others. Photographs from February 6, 1994, Continued: Dee Dee Myers talks with Andrew Friendly, Jeff Eller, and Bruce Lindsey at the Wortham Center. President Clinton attends the American Cancer Society Children's Party at the Four Seasons Hotel in Houston. President Clinton visits with children and a young boy puts his arms around the President and his head on the President's shoulder. President Clinton visits and dines at Chuy's Restaurant in Houston. President Clinton stands next to an Elvis Presley Shrine at Chuy's. President Clinton greets Wyndham Warwick Hotel personnel in Houston. Photographs from February 7, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton jogs in Houston with police officers of the Houston Police Department. President Clinton visits and tours the Johnson Space Center in Houston. President Clinton watches a demonstration of the shuttle arm and views a mock-up of the Space Shuttle and Space Station. The President pilots a shuttle simulator and tours Building Thirty Mission Control. President Clinton greets employees and talks on the telephone to shuttle astronauts in space. President Clinton is accompanied on his tour by Representative Jack Brooks. President Clinton greets local supporters at a reception at the Wyndham Warwick Hotel in Houston. President Clinton addresses the Greater Houston Partnership at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Houston. Participants include Ken Lay, President, Greater Houston Partnership, Mayor Bob Lanier, and Secretary Lloyd Bentsen. President Clinton greets family members of Wendy Smith and Grace Garcia at the Hyatt Regency Hotel. President Clinton talks alone with Mack McLarty and Bruce Lindsey. President Clinton waves from the top step of Air Force One and departs Houston and travels to Louisiana. President Clinton meets with Jeff Eller, Dee Dee Myers, and Mack McLarty in his office aboard Air Force One. The President also

meets with Bill Burton and Bruce Lindsey in his office during the flight. President Clinton greets a USIA reporter on Air Force One. Photographs from February 7, 1994, Continued: President Clinton arrives at Barksdale Air Force Base in Bossier City, Louisiana. The President greets health care letter writers from Louisiana. President Clinton greets local supporters at the Officer's Club at Barksdale Air Force Base. President Clinton dines at Dominic's Restaurant in Shreveport. Louisiana. Dinner guests include Senator John Breaux, Senator J. Bennett Johnston, Representative William Jefferson, Representative Cleo Hayes, and others. President Clinton talks with Wendy Smith at the restaurant. Bruce Lindsey and Andrew Friendly are present at the restaurant. The President greets restaurant personnel. Photographs from February 8, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton jogs with Senator J. Bennett Johnston, and others in Shreveport. The President greets people on Travis Street in Shreveport. President Clinton visits the General Motors (GM) North American Truck Platforms Shreveport Assembly Plant. President Clinton addresses plant employees. Participants include Guy Briggs, Vice President, GM, Steve Yokich, Vice President, United Auto Workers, Owen Bieber, President, United Auto Workers, and Jack Smith, CEO, GM. The President shakes hands with employees in the crowd. The President greets a boy from the Make-A-Wish Foundation at the GM event. President Clinton participates in an interview in Shreveport with Detroit Regional Media at the General Motors North American Truck Platform. President Clinton stops along the motorcade route to talk to people lining the streets in Shreveport. The President talks to the crowd using the Presidential limousine public address microphone. President Clinton boards Air Force One at Barksdale Air Force Base to travel back to Andrews Air Force Base. President Clinton talks with Bruce Lindsey and Wendy Smith in his office aboard Air Force One. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Ambassador Kiuchi, Special Envoy of Prime Minister Hosokawa of Japan. Participants include National Security Advisor Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, Bowman Cutter, and Mickey Kantor. Hillary Rodham Clinton and Tipper Gore address the National Women's Political Caucus at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
