Summary

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 18) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created from February 7, 1994, February 25, 1994 through February 26, 1994, and February 28, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed. Photographs from February 7, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton visits the General Motors North American truck platform Shreveport assembly plant in Shreveport, Louisiana. Photographs from February 25, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton greets Admiral David Jeremiah in the Oval Office. Following the greeting the President participates in an interview with Dave Yepsen of the Des Moines Register. Following the interview the President participates in a meeting with David Gergen, Mack McLarty, and George Stephanopoulos. In the Outer Oval Office, the President takes a phone call. Also present include Betty Currie, Pamela Harriman, and Mike Feldman. President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Paul Begala in the West Wing of the White House. The

President proceeds to a meeting in the Roosevelt Room with Pat Griffin and Harold Ickes. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with cabinet members and staff at Blair House. Present include Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Secretary of the Interior Bruce Babbitt, Secretary of Energy Hazel O'Leary, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Secretary of Veterans Affairs Jesse Brown, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Defense William Perry, Madeline Albright, Leon Panetta, Carol Browner, Mack McLarty, Christine Varney, Phil Lader, and Laura Tyson. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., congratulate the University of Virginia 1993 NCAA Champions men's soccer team. The President greets the team and guests present. Also photographed includes Senator Charles Robb, Ed Emerson, Mark Gearan, and Mike Feldman. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Senator Kent Conrad, health care legislative assistant Craig Obey, Mary Wakefield, and Chris Jennings. Also photographed are Melanne Vermeer and Pam Barnett. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaks with Capricia Marshall, Betty Currie, Nancy Hennrich, Mike Feldman, and Mark Gearan in the Outer Oval Office. The First Lady proceeds to the West Wing where she greets Senator Paul Wellstone and Sheila Wellstone. Tony Lake greets departing staff members in the West Wing of the White House. Photographs from February 26, 1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address from the First District police headquarters in Washington, DC. Following the address the President greets individuals present. Photographed includes Dee Dee Myers. The President returns to the White House via the Presidential motorcade. President William Jefferson Clinton greets a girl scout troop visiting the White House. Photographed includes Andrea Fisher McNeely, Katie McNeely, Christopher McNeely, Brian Rock, and Vernon Jordan, among others. Later the President greets members of the New York High School basketball team. Also photographed includes Bill Staton and Carolyn Ellis Staton. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Pat O'Brian of CBS at the White House. Photographed includes Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, and George Stephanopoulos, among others. (February 26, 1994 continued) President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed with Vernon Jordan, Brian McPartlin, and Bob Armstrong at Andrews Air Force Base Chelsea Clinton, Mike Feldman, Brian McPartlin, and Jonathan Prince hold & pose with Socks the cat at the White House. Tony Lake and Mark Gearan greet the University of Massachusetts basketball team at the White House. Photographs from February 28,

1994 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Chicago O'Hare International Airport. The President greets Representative Dan Rostenkowski, Mayor Richard Daley, Attorney General Roland Burris, State Treasurer Pat Quinn, State Comptroller Dawn Clark Netch, and state party chairman Gary Lapaille. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Wright Community College in Chicago, Illinois. The President is met by Chancellor of City Colleges of Chicago Dr. Ronald Temple, Chairman of City Colleges board Ronald Gidwitz, and President of Wright Community College Raymond Lefevour. The President proceeds to a holding room where he calls Nancy Kerrigan to congratulate her on winning the silver medal in figure skating at the winter Olympics. Following the call, the President participates in a roundtable discussion on crime and health care. Following the event, the President delivers a speech to students in the gymnasium. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Hillcrest High School in Country Club Hills, Illinois. The President delivers a speech to students. Present on the dais includes Representative Mel Reynolds, Principal Lee Nelson and Vice President of the Senior Class Starr Nelson. President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Chicago O'Hare International Airport via Marine One. The President greets guests in attendance. The President boards Air Force One en route Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The President arrives at Pittsburgh International Airport. The President is met by Mayor Tom Murphy, Senator Harris Wofford, Representatives William Coyne & Austin Murphy, County Commissioners Pete Flaherty, Tom Forrester & Larry Dunn, and State Park Chairman Bill Lincoln, among others. The President greets Prime Minister John Major of Great Britain. The President and Prime Minister proceed to make remarks at the Air Force Reserve Base. President William Jefferson Clinton & Prime Minister John Major meet with Matthew Aloe. President William Jefferson Clinton & Prime Minister John Major meet at the Tin Angel Restaurant in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Also present are Jane Holl and Tony Lake. The President and Prime Minister watch fireworks over Pittsburgh. Following the event, the President and Prime Minister proceed to Pittsburgh International Airport for departure en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President and Prime Minister greet guests present before embarking upon Air Force One. Still shots of Air Force One on the tarmac at Andrews Air Force Base.
