Approximately 2,100 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from February 28, 1994, through March 3, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular importance is an official visit of Prime Minister John Major of Great Britain.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 19) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken February 28, 1994, through March 3, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from February 28, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton arrives at Pittsburgh International Airport in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. President Clinton greets Prime Minister John Major of Great Britain, and they make remarks at the airport. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major meet with Matthew Aloe, Make a Wish Foundation child and his family. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major shop for souvenirs in shops in the Galleria and Town Center area of Pittsburgh. Prime Minister Major autographs an "England" t-shirt and President Clinton buys sporting goods at the shops. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major participate in a working dinner at the Tin Angel Restaurant in Pittsburgh. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major watch a display of fireworks over Pittsburgh. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major ride a funicular railway to

the Duquesne Incline Observation Deck. President Clinton greets local police and others at Pittsburgh International Airport. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major board Air Force One and depart Pittsburgh. They meet aboard Air Force One during their flight to Washington, D.C. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton hosts a tea with reporters in New York, New York including Cindy Adams, New York Post, Liz Smith, Newsday, Jeannie Williams, USA Today, and Linda Stassi, New York Daily News. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tours King County Hospital in Brooklyn, New York. Tour participants include Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Senator Dianne Feinstein, Senator Barbara Mikulski, and others. The First Lady participates in a health care meeting in the hospital's board room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets volunteers, police, and others prior to departing for Andrews Air Force Base at LaGuardia Airport in New York. President Clinton boards Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base and departs for Chicago, Illinois. Photographs from March 1, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton greets Representative Jim Slattery in the Oval Office. Photographs from March 1, 1994, Continued: President Clinton has breakfast in the White House Solarium with British Prime Minister John Major. President Clinton confers in the Diplomatic Reception Room with Sandy Berger, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, Dee Dee Myers, Jane Holl, and others. President Clinton and Prime Minister Major talk to the press gathered on the South Lawn. President Clinton accompanies Prime Minister Major at the South Portico prior to the Prime Minister's departure from the White House. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore meet with the House Budget Committee in the Roosevelt Room. Representative Martin Olav Sabo, Leon Panetta, and others are present at the meeting. President Clinton greets a group from Arkansas in the Grand Foyer of the White House. President Clinton walks alone with Mike Feldman on the White House Colonnade. Attorney General Janet Reno meets in the West Wing with Director Louis Freeh, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the West Wing with Representative Lynn Schenk. President Clinton greets Shelby Moore and an unidentified man in the Oval Office. Betty Currie sits at her desk with Socks the cat and a replica Vince Lombardi Super Bowl Trophy in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton meets with Representative Peter Hoagland and Steve Ricchetti in the Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Brookings Institute in Washington, D.C. and she delivers remarks in the auditorium. Photographs from March 2, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton wears a "Jason Project" baseball hat and a "Jason V Belize 1994" t-shirt on the Ground Floor prior to his workout. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator

Jeff Bingaman, Carrie Billy, and Ira Magaziner. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the West Wing with Senator David Boren, Beth Garrett, Mendi Sossamon, and Ira Magaziner. President Clinton greets Nancy Hernreich and her friend in the Oval Office. President Clinton participated in a telephone conference call in the Oval Office with Older Americans regarding Health Care. President Clinton talks with reporters in the Oval Office following the conference call. Dee Dee Myers and George Stephanopoulos are present during the telephone call. President Clinton talks on the Oval Office telephone to King Hussein of Jordan. President Clinton drops by a briefing in the Roosevelt Room for the leadership of Central and Eastern European Countries. Alexis Herman and Strobe Talbott are present at the meeting. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Representative Richard Lehman. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the West Wing with Senator Joseph Lieberman, Bill Bonvillian, and Elizabeth Drye. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Robert Reich, Secretary Robert Rubin, Mark Gearan, and Nancy Hernreich, President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore participate in a strategy meeting in the Old Family Dining Room with David Wilhem, Mack McLarty, Sandy Berger, Jack Quinn, Ricki Seidman, Mark Gearan, and Maggie Williams. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Paul Begala, Mark Gearan, Bob Boorstin, James Carville, and Mandy Grunwald. The President prepares for his interview with "CBS This Morning." Photographs from March 2, 1994, Continued: President Clinton visits with Paula Zahn and Harry Smith of CBS News in the Oval Office. The President participates in an interview for "CBS This Morning" in the White House Library. President Clinton participates in an interview with Peggy Waymayer of "ABC World News" in the White House Library. President Clinton joins friends and staff to watch a University of Arkansas Basketball game in the Family Theatre. Guests present include Carolyn Staley, Jamie Williams, Catherine Cornelius, James Lee Witt, Chad Griffin, Helen Dickey, and others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at the watch party. Photographs from March 3, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office to former President Richard Nixon. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore address a Reinventing Government (REGO) event in the Roosevelt Room. Participants at the event include Dan Beard, Bureau of Reclamation, and Joan Hyatt, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Inspector. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, David Gergen, Dee Dee Myers, Bowman Cutter, George Stephanopoulos prior to the President's telephone call to Prime Minister Morihiro Hoskawa of Japan. President Clinton talks on the Oval Office

telephone to Prime Minister Morihiro Hosokawa of Japan. Present for the telephone call include Vice President Albert Gore, Robert Kyle, David Gergen, Dee Dee Myers, Bowman Cutter. Following the telephone call the President confers in the Oval Office with George Stephanopoulos, David Gergen, Mark Gearan, and Dee Dee Myers. President Clinton arrives at the Bethesda Naval Hospital landing zone aboard Marine One. President Clinton meets with Representative William Natcher and presents him a medal and a citation. President Clinton greets hospital staff and patients. President Clinton departs Bethesda on Marine One. Photographs include aerial views of the Washington, D.C. skyline showing the Lincoln Memorial, Reflecting Pool, and the Washington Monument. President Clinton talks in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Sandy Berger, and others. Photographs from March 3, 1994, Continued: President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Mike Feldman in between Thursday photo opportunities. President Clinton meets with Edward Lowe and Erskine Bowles in the Oval Office. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Larry Lawrence new U.S. Ambassador to Switzerland. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Girl Scouts and Brownies in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB) Studio and in an OEOB hallway.
