## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment were created from March 3, 1994, through March 8, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 20) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken March 3, 1994, through March 8, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from March 3, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging near the Lincoln Memorial Reflecting Pool and Tidal Basin in Washington, D.C. President Clinton greets people during his jogging outing. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Christy Carpenter in the West Wing area of the White House. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore participate in a Reinventing Government (REGO) event in the Roosevelt Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a satellite feed for the Children's Defense Fund in the Old Executive Office Building (EOOB) studio. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a dinner in the residence for members of Congress including Senator Ernest Hollings, Senator George Mitchell, Senator Christopher Dodd, Senator Barbara Boxer, Senator John Breaux, Senator Jay Rockefeller, Senator Bob Graham, Senator Harry Reid, Tipper

Gore, Mack McLarty, Pat Griffin, Harold Ickes, and Steve Ricchetti. President Clinton visits with guests in the Lincoln Bedroom, the Lincoln Sitting Room, and the Treaty Room. Photographs from March 4, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets in the Oval Office prior to his meetings with President Leonid Kravchuk of Ukraine with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Sandy Berger, Nicholas Burns, Rose Gottemoeller, Secretary William Perry, and others. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with President Leonid Kravchuk of Ukraine, Yuhym Zvyahilskiy, Acting Prime Minister, Anatoliy Zlenko, Foreign Minister, Oleh Bilorus, Ukrainian Ambassador to the U.S., Anton Buteyko, Adviser to President Kravchuk on International Affairs. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary William Perry, and Ambassador William Miller. President Clinton greets Ukrainian Ice Skaters Oksana Baiul and Viktor Petrenko in the Oval Office following his meeting with President Kravchuk. President Clinton and President Kravchuk walk alone on the White House Colonnade towards the residence. They talk in the State Dining Room prior to a lunch meeting in the Old Family Dining Room. Photographs from March 4, 1994, Continued: President Clinton and President Kravchuk participate in a working lunch in the Old Family Dining Room with Yuhym Zvyahilskiy, Acting Prime Minister, Anatoliy Zlenko, Foreign Minister, Oleh Bilorus, Ukrainian Ambassador to the U.S., Anton Buteyko, Adviser to President Kravchuk on International Affairs, Defense Minister Vitaliy Radetsky, Chairman Yevhen Marchuk, Foreign Minister Hryhoriy Pyatachenko, and Minister of Economy Roman Shpek. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Secretary William Perry, Sandy Berger, Leon Fuerth, Ambassador William Miller, and others. President Clinton and President Kravchuk sign three documents in the East Room. The documents include a Joint Statement of Cooperation, Bilateral Investment Treaty, and the Double Taxation Treaty. Secretary Warren Christopher and Foreign Minister Zlenko sign two documents in the East Room. The documents include Agreement on the Protection of Cultural Heritage and the Science and Technology Agreement. President Clinton escorts President Kravchuk to the North Portico driveway. President Clinton talks to reporters in the Grand Foyer. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore meet with health care supporters in the Cabinet Room. Portrait photographs of Karen Finney in the White House Phil Lader poses for a photo with an intern in the West Wing of the White House. President Clinton participates in an interview in the Oval Office with Marian Burros. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks alone with Lisa Caputo in the East Wing Colonnade area. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview

in the White House Library with Meryl Gordon, Elle Magazine. The First Lady participates in a photo shoot with Timothy Greenfield-Sanders in the Family Theatre. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton attend a performance of "Grease" at the National Theatre in Washington, D.C. The Clintons greet performers backstage at the theatre. President Clinton tries on an actor's zebra skinned coat while he is backstage. The Clintons return to the White House after the performance and walk through the Diplomatic Reception Room

Photographs from March 4, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the West Wing with Senator Bill Bradley, Chris Jennings, Melanne Verveer, Ira Magaziner, Lauren Ewers, Michael Dahl, and others. President Clinton talks with Nancy Hernreich, Mike Feldman, and Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton looks at glass sculptures in the Outer Oval Office. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a "Children and the News Media" satellite feed in the Old Executive Office Building (EOB) studio with Lucile Packard Children's Hospital at Stanford University. In addition, the First Lady participates in a video for the National Farmers Union Annual Convention. Photographs from March 5, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton delivers a live radio address in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets David Gergen and guests after the address. President Clinton participates in a videotaping session in the Map Room. President Clinton talks with Martin Indyk in the Map Room. President Clinton talks alone with George Stephanopoulos in the hallway of the Ground Floor residence. President Clinton walks along the White House Colonnade with Bernard Nussbaum. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, and her friend cross the South Lawn together to depart for Camp David. Photographs from March 6, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, and her friend arrive on the South Lawn aboard Marine One. They cross the South Lawn and greet visitors on their return from Camp David. Photographs from March 7, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. President Clinton pets Socks the cat next to a tree on the South Grounds of the White House. President Clinton attends a Habitat for Humanity event in Washington, D.C. President Clinton addresses the event and participants include Mayor Sharon Pratt Kelly and former Mayor Marion Barry. Chairman Eduard Shevardnadze of Georgia (Republic) arrives at the North Porte Cochere entrance of the West Wing at the White House. Following Chairman Shevardnadze's departure President Clinton walks along the White House Colonnade towards the West Wing with Vice President Albert Gore, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, David Gergen, and Sandy Berger. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Nicholas Burns, Rosemarie Forsythe, Leon Fuerth, Sandy Berger, and Strobe Talbott. Photographs from March 8, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Dr. Philippe Douste-Blazy, M.D. Minister of Health for France, Mrs. Maryvonne Douste-Blazy, M.D., Christopher LeCourtier, Advisor, International Affairs, Pascal Chevit, M.D. Counselor for Social Action, Embassy of France, and others in the Map Room. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Lloyd Cutler, and Mack McLarty address a staff meeting in the East Room.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
