Summary

This collection consists of electronic correspondence from Will Marshall to the White House. The collection contains correspondence to the White House.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2021-0329-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. The researcher submitted a request for records containing correspondence from Will Marshall to the White House. Will Marshall is the president and founder of the Progressive Policy Institute (PPI). Founded in 1989, PPI served as the think tank arm of the Democratic Leadership Council (DLC), founded by Al From, until it dissolved in 2011. The Progressive Policy Institute and the DLC promoted more centrist Democratic ideals, including the New Democrat and “Third Way” movements. Mr. Marshall remains active in the PPI to this day and writes about policy matters for a variety of publications.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic

Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
