Summary

This collection consists of records related to news articles and weekly Cabinet-level summaries mentioning Dorothy Dwoskin. Dorothy Dwoskin was Assistant U.S. Trade Representative (AUTR) for the World Trade Organization (WTO) and Multilateral Affairs at the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) from 1993-2007. This collection only contains emails.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2021-0518-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Dorothy Dwoskin was Assistant U.S. Trade Representative (AUTR) for the World Trade Organization (WTO) and Multilateral Affairs at the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) from 1993-2007. The focus of economic policy in relation to China during AUTR Dwoskin's tenure was largely on Chinese accession to the WTO. China began the process of joining the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) in 1986. Though not a member, China was a signatory to the Uruguay Round of GATT in 1994. Following the formation of the WTO, China continued the process of bilateral negotiations with the members of the WTO on trade and services with the goal of acceding to the organization. Materials responsive to this FOIA request include emails regarding news articles and weekly Cabinet level summaries mentioning Dorothy Dwoskin. Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas— Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Automated Records Management System [Email]; Clinton Presidential Records: (SAS) Tape Restoration Project [Email]. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email. The Tape Restoration Project (TRP) is a database consisting of restored emails from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) from July 1994 through June of 2000. The TRP is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
