Summary

This collection contains documents regarding David Geffen who was an entertainment mogul and known Democratic party fundraiser in the 1990s. This collection includes background materials, briefing papers, and correspondence regarding Geffen. Topics include Geffen's attendance to White House events, the President's, First Lady's, and Geffen's attendance to events outside the White House, the President's telephone calls and birthday greetings to Geffen, gifts sent from the President to Geffen, and Geffen's contributions to the White House's New Markets initiative and AIDS service organizations.

Scope and Content Note

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas—Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alpha Files, Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, and Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 - 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
