He provided information to White House staff by collecting information, verifying facts, and researching opposing viewpoints, in areas such as education, health care, welfare, taxes, and budgets. 2025-0373-S consists of correspondence, memoranda, emails, newspaper and magazine articles, invitations, reports, schedules, speeches, press releases, talking points, statistical material and handwritten notes.
