Summary

This collection contains records from the files of Colonel Keirn "K.C." Brown related to the military conflict in and around Kosovo. Colonel Brown served as a Director for European Affairs on the National Security Council. His files contain memorandums, emails, cables, notes, and drafts related to ongoing conflict in Kosovo. The records particularly address the political-military planning in the United States and NATO as the crisis intensified in late 1998 and early 1999.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2019-0922-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains records from the files of Keirn Brown on the military conflict in and around Kosovo. A U.S. Army Colonel, K.C. Brown served as a Director for European Affairs on the National Security Council in 1998 and 1999. It was the final assignment of his 30-year military career. His files contain memorandums, emails, cables, notes, and drafts related to the ongoing conflict in Kosovo. The records particularly address the political-military planning in the United States and NATO as the crisis intensified in late 1998 and early 1999.
