Summary

This collection contains materials related to Robert Reich and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), between January 20, 1993 and December 8, 1993. Robert Reich served as President Clinton's first Secretary of Labor from 1993 until 1997, and was one of the leading spokesmen for NAFTA in the Clinton administration. This collection is comprised of NSC Cables and Emails relating to NAFTA negotiations and meetings, as well as related trade issues.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2023-0715-F (Segment 3) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains materials related to Robert Reich and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), between the dates of January 20, 1993 and December 8, 1993—the date President Clinton signed the trade agreement into law. Robert Reich was confirmed as President Clinton's first Secretary of Labor on January 21, 1993, and served in that role until 1997. He was one of the leading proponents and spokesmen for NAFTA in the Clinton administration. This collection is comprised of NSC Cables and Emails relating to NAFTA negotiations and meetings, as well as related trade issues.
