Summary

This collection consists of records related to the Taxpayer Relief Act. The collection contains duplicates of an August 5, 1997 Statement by the President concerning his approval of H.R. 2014, the "Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997;" records related to H.R. 45179, "the Taxpayer Relief Act of 1998;" Legislative Referral Memorandums (LRM) and Legislative Reports concerning the status of the Tax Payer Relief Act; and correspondence concerning tuition waivers a provision under the Taxpayer Relief Act.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2025-0091-F (Segment 1) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection consists of records related to the Taxpayer Relief Act. The electronic records responsive to this request consist of email correspondence containing the search term, "Taxpayer Relief Act." According to records responsive to this request, under the H.R. 2014 "The Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997" Owners of brownfields were offered a tax deduction for remediation efforts; Billions of Dollars of Tax Relief were provided for small businesses; tax credits were provided to pay interest on bonds related to public school renovations; and 2.3 Billion dollars were provided to AMTRAK for capital improvements. The Executive Office of the President (EOP) subsystem of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Clinton Administration officials. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program. The Automated Records Management System (ARMS) is a database that contains email records of the Executive Office of the President. This system maintained unclassified Presidential email.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain.
