**Summary**

This collection consists of records related to Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrator Carol Browner and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), between January 20 and December 8, 1993. The collection contains NSC cables and an email related to trade negotiations and collaborative environmental protection work between the United States, Canada, and Mexico.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2023-0716-F (Segment 2) are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains records related to Carol Browner and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), between the dates of January 20, 1993 and December 8, 1993—the date the trade agreement was signed into law by President Clinton. Ms. Browner served as the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for all eight years of President Clinton’s administration. Records opened in this collection include NSC cables and email related to trade negotiations and collaborative environmental protection work between the United States, Canada, and Mexico.
