Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from July 11, 1994, through July 12, 1994 & July 18, 1994, through July 22, 1994. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 71) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken July 11, 1994, through July 12, 1994; July 15, 1994; July 18, 1994, through July 22, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from July 11, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton walks on the grounds of Villa Hammerschmidt in Bonn, Germany with German President Roman Herzog and Chancellor Helmut Kohl. President Clinton and Chancellor Kohl participate in a press statement on the grounds. Photographs from July 12, 1994, are as follows: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Hannelore Kohl attend the commencement ceremony at the John F. Kennedy High School in Berlin, Germany. Photographs from July 15, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton greets volunteers at the Westmoreland County Airport in Latrobe, Pennsylvania after delivering a health care speech. President Clinton departs Latrobe and travels to Philadelphia. Photographs from July 17, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton attends a dinner for a tribute to Senator Robert Byrd in Washington, D.C.

Photographs from July 18, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets in the Miami Convention Center with Alexis Herman, Bruce Lindsey, Secretary Henry Cisneros, and others prior to attending the National Council of La Raza luncheon in Miami, Florida. President Clinton talks to reporters in the press pool prior to his departure from Miami International Airport and travels to Maine. Photographs from July 18, 1994, Continued: President Clinton arrives at Brunswick Naval Air Station in Portland, Maine and greets students on the tarmac. President Clinton greets police officers prior to departing Portland and travels to Boston, Massachusetts. Photographs from July 19, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets with the Boston Globe Editorial Boards at the Hynes Convention Center in Boston. President Clinton talks to Bruce Lindsey, Mark Gearan, and John Hart in the convention center hallway. President Clinton works on his National Governors Association meeting speech with Mark Gearan, Marcia Hale, Dee Dee Myers, Bruce Lindsey, and others at the convention center in Boston. President Clinton meets with Governor William Weld of Massachusetts at the convention center. President Clinton meets with Nancy Soderberg at the convention center. President Clinton greets Governor Lowell Weicker, Timothy Shriver, President of the 1995 Special Olympics World Games Organizing Committee, Susan Saint James, and others affiliated with the Special Olympics at the Hynes Convention Center. President Clinton greets police officers in the parking garage of the Park Plaza Hotel in Boston. President Clinton greets people and is interviewed by a young boy at Boston Logan Airport. President Clinton departs Boston and travels back to Andrews Air Force Base. During the flight President Clinton talks in the hallway to Dee Dee Myers and Mark Gearan joins them. President Clinton talks with staff in the conference room including Dee Dee Myers, Andrew Friendly, Josh King, and others. Erksine Bowles, Small Business Administrator, meets with Robert Rubin and others in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Photographs from July 20, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, William Gray, Sandy Berger, Leon Fuerth, Strobe Talbott, and John Deutch, Deputy Secretary of Defense, regarding Haiti. President Clinton meets alone with Leon Panetta in the Oval Office. President Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room with Democratic Congressional leadership. Participants include Representative Tom Foley, Senator George Mitchell, Representative David Bonior, Senator Barbara Mikulski, Representative John Lewis, Representative Richard Gephardt, Senator John Breaux, Senator Bob Graham, Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, Mack McLarty, Representative Barbara Kennelly, Representative Steny Hoyer, and others. Following the meeting President Clinton talks alone with Senator

Mitchell. The President confers with Vice President Gore, Harold Ickes, and George Stephanopoulos. President Clinton meets alone with Dr. John "Jack" Gibbons, Director of the Office of Science and Technology, regarding the Apollo 11 Anniversary. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Vice President Albert Gore greet the Apollo 11 Astronauts: Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin, and Michael Collins in the Oval Office. President Clinton along with the Apollo 11 Astronauts walk through the Rose Garden to the residence. President Clinton, Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin, and others participate in the 25th Anniversary of the Apollo 11 Moon Landing Space Mission ceremony in the East Room. President Clinton addresses the ceremony. The First Lady meets with the wives of the Apollo 11 Astronauts in the Blue Room. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Capitol Hill and is met by Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy. The First Lady greets the National Home Care Board of Directors. The First Lady looks over notes with Melanne Verveer, Kelly Craighead, and others. The First Lady addresses a Healthright event in the Dirksen Building at the U.S. Capitol. Participants include Senator Tom Daschle, Senator Edward Kennedy, Senator Paul Wellstone, Senator Harris Wofford, Senator Jay Rockefeller, and Harry Reid. The First Lady holds a small child named Ryan Moore in her arms during her speech. President Clinton meets with Panamanian President-Elect Perez Balladares in the Oval Office. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Strobe Talbott, Tony Lake, and others. President Clinton greets Skip Holland. Debi Schiff is present in the Oval Office. Photographs from July 20, 1994, Continued: First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses Connecticut and New Jersey Opinion Leaders in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Alexis Herman and Doris Matsui are on the dais. The First Lady uses visual aids to illustrate points on health care. Mack McLarty meets in the West Wing with Shelton Smith and Sylvia Deleon. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton looks at a table set for a formal dinner in the State Dining Room. Kelly Craighead and Nancy Clarke are present. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator Robert Byrd. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator John Breaux. President Clinton talks with Pat Griffin and George Stephanopoulos in the Outer Oval Office. Leon Panetta also joins the group. President Clinton and Leon Panetta walk along the White House Colonnade to the residence. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Steve Graham and Mort Engelberg in the hallway at the Reichstag in Berlin, Germany. Photographs from July 21, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes jogging on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. The White House Press Pool waits for the President at the White House. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets at the U.S. Capitol with

Representative Richard Gephardt, Representative Barbara Kennelly, Representative Benjamin Cardin, Representative Bill Richardson, and others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton embraces Lisa Caputo and Melanne Verveer on the Ground Floor residence area of the White House. President Clinton signs legislation in the Oval Office that transfers full control of the Kennedy Center from the National Park Service to the Center's Board of Trustees. President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with President-Elect Leonid Kuchma of Ukraine. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Sheila Lawrence in the Map Room. President Clinton meets with Senator George Mitchell, Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton. Vice President Gore jokes with Leon Panetta and Senator Mitchell in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton meets with Senator Herb Kohl in the Oval Office. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore meet in the Roosevelt Room with Vladimir Shumeyko, Speaker of the Russian Federation Council, and others. Photographs from July 21, 1994, Continued: President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator Max Baucus. The President and Senator Baucus talk with Vice President Albert Gore and Leon Panetta in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton meets alone with Paul Richard in the Oval Office. Photographs from July 22, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton meets in the Oval Office prior to his announcement on U.S. aid to Rwanda

with Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, Deputy Secretary of Defense John Deutch, General John Shalikashvili, Brian Atwood, and others. President Clinton announces U.S. aid to Rwanda from the Press Briefing Room. Present at the announcement include Ambassador Madeleine Albright, General Shalikashvili, Deputy Secretary of Defense Deutch, Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, and others. President Clinton works at his Oval Office desk with Vice President Albert Gore and Leon Panetta standing nearby. President Clinton confers with Vice President Gore, Dee Dee Myers, George Stephanopoulos, and Mark Gearan. Leon Panetta talks alone with Mack McLarty in the Oval Office. President Clinton meets with Senator Dianne Feinstein in the Oval Office. President Clinton meets with Senator Frank Lautenberg in the Oval Office. Present at the meeting include Senator Robert Dole, Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Vice President Albert Gore, and others.
