Approximately 1,492 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created from April 4, 1994 & July 26, 1994, through July 28, 1994. Numerous photo contact sheets from July 28, 1994, were previously processed in case 2022-0199-F. The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 74) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken April 4, 1994; July 26, 1994, through July 28, 1994. The following search terms were used to conduct the search: "P18400," "P18401," "P18402," etc., through "P18499." Numerous photo contact sheets from July 28, 1994, were previously processed in case 2022- 0199-F. The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from April 4, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend the annual Easter Egg Roll on the South Lawn of the White House. President Clinton makes remarks and blows a whistle to start the egg races. The First Lady greets people on the South Lawn. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Neel Lattimore's family in the Diplomatic Reception Room. President Clinton holds a basketball and stands on the White House North Lawn driveway. The President participates in a promotional video recording for the NCAA Men's Basketball

Championship. Photographs from July 26, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, King Hussein I, and Queen Noor of Jordan, and Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin and Leah Rabin of Israel, attend a reception and dinner at the U.S. Department of State in Washington, D.C. The leaders look at views of Washington from the terrace at the Department of State. Vice President Albert Gore, Tipper Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Shimon Peres, Mary Mel French, and others are present with the leaders at the reception. The leaders address the dinner. President Clinton meets with Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel in the Oval Office. Meeting participants include Shimon Peres, Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Dennis Ross, and Martin Indyk. Prior to the meeting the President confers in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Dennis Ross, Martin Indyk, George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan and Bob Boorstin. President Clinton, King Hussein of Jordan, and Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel participate in a press conference in the East Room of the White House. Photographs from July 27, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Vice President Albert Gore address the California Day reception in the East Room. The Clintons confer with Capricia Marshall, Kelly Craighead, and Sarah Ryan prior to the reception. The Clintons greet Nancy Sinatra in the East Room. Kelly Craighead, Ann Stock, Sarah Ryan, and John Emerson pose for photos in the East Room. The Clintons walk along the White House Colonnade towards the residence. President Clinton talks to Dr. Glenn Anderson via telephone relay call in the Oval Office. The President looks at a television monitor during the call. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore talk with First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Harold Ickes, Pat Griffin, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Ira Magaziner, and Steve Ricchetti in the Oval Office. President Clinton works in the Oval Office with Stanley Herr and Mike Lux on his speech for the Americans with Disabilities event. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Tipper Gore, and Senator Tom Harkin participate in the celebration of the 4th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act on the South Lawn. President Clinton addresses the ceremony. Dais participants include Justin Dart. Prior to the event the Clintons and others congregate in the Map Room of the White House. President Clinton confers in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Harold Ickes, Pat Griffin, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos after the Americans with Disabilities event. President Clinton meets with Senator George Mitchell, Vice President Albert Gore, Pat Griffin, Leon Panetta, and Ira Magaziner in the Oval Office. President Clinton

greeted Senator Mitchell's staff members. President Clinton greeted medical professionals (medics) in the West Garden Room of the White House. President Clinton works on his health care speech in the Oval Office Dining Room with George Stephanopoulos, Harold Ickes, Don Baer, David Kusnet, and Mark Gearan. Photographs from July 27, 1994, Continued: President Clinton honors the NCAA Women's Basketball Champion University of North Carolina Tar Heels in an East Room ceremony. Coach Sylvia Hatchell presents the President with a Chapel Hill Basketball shirt. President Clinton talks on the telephone with Sr. Leonard Lawrence, outgoing President of the National Medical Association, in the Oval Office. President Clinton confers in the Oval Office with Steve Ricchetti, Chris Jennings, and Pat Griffin. President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator Ben Nighthorse Campbell.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
