

## **Summary**

This Mandatory Declassification Review contains correspondence between President William J. Clinton and Presidents of Bolivia: Jaime Paz Zamora, Gonzalo Sanchez de Lozada, and Hugo Banzer Suarez. The collection consists wholly of National Security Council Records Management System documents. Topics discussed include Bolivian-U.S. bilateral relations, Summit of the Americas, and the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC).
