These Clinton Presidential Records were declassified in response to a Mandatory Declassification Review request related to documents from collection 2011-0516-S, Records of Philip J. "P.J." Crowley, National Security Council, Press Office. Specifically these records are related to China and 1993 discussions of Most Favored Nation status. Records to be opened include briefing papers, reports, and memorandum on China policy.
