This Mandatory Declassification Review contains records related to Russian President Boris Yeltsin. Materials include an August 24, 1998 memorandum for the President regarding a telephone call with Yeltsin, an October 5, 1998 memorandum of telephone conversation (telcon) between Clinton and Yeltsin, and a memorandum from Samuel Berger to the President regarding a message to Yeltsin on Kosovo.
